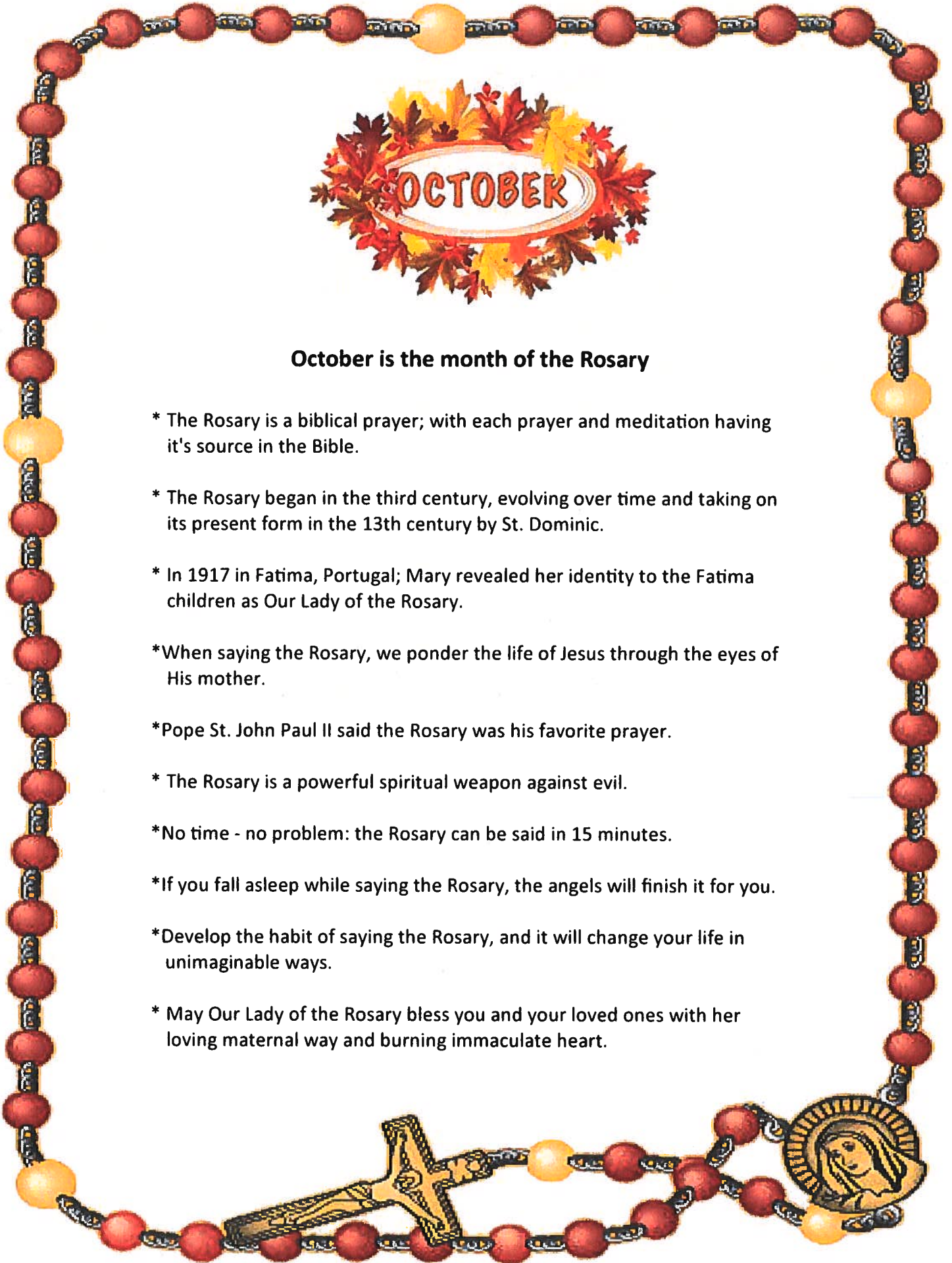




October is the month of the Rosary


