

Dear People of God,

As your pastor I want to take time to share with you a few thoughts on the Historic Church of St. Patrick. The year I arrived here as pastor, the parish was beginning the implementation of its strategic plan to address current and future needs/growth of the community. What followed has been an unprecedented development of what the Church calls "Adult Formation." I say that because many pastors agonize over attempts to get adults involved in anything that grows their knowledge of the faith and of our Church. Today there are programs offering Bible study, Catholicism, and the Alpha process. All of these are well organized and function as teaching moments for those involved. My profound gratitude to those who put together and run these programs and my invitation to others to come along and experience the great things that happen as we learn more and more about the God of love.

Under the auspices of the Evangelization Committee we've seen other areas grow as well. Social gatherings, always difficult in a parish that has no parish hall, have become a regular and popular series, including trips to the Mud Hens and Walleye, backyard potlucks, Pints with the Pastor, the parish picnic, and the recent Hobo dinner. These events, together with weekend hospitality, give us the opportunity to build a social community so that we know and appreciate one another beyond simply filling the pews.

Our outreach programs are equally impressive, be it the pantry or the Sunday morning soup kitchen, both of which rely on the kindness of volunteers and parishioners who regularly donate to the support of those programs. With the expansion of the pantry into the garage and a couple of Scouting projects, the pantry has been able to affirm the dignity of our client base while growing our capacity to serve their needs. Perhaps when my term as pastor comes to its inevitable end, we will have replaced the aged garage with a suitable dedicated pantry space that continues to fulfill the Great Command to love our neighbor.

Strategic planning tends to bring about both vision and accomplishment and we now boast committees which were not on the radar six years ago. A dedicated Social Committee has been established to seek other ways to bring us together while a Safety Committee continues to assess ways and means of keeping all of us in a secure setting whenever we come to the campus. Thanks be to God and to all of you who have so wholeheartedly made my task as pastor a burden which is light, a yoke which is easy.

May God bless you all.

#### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick**: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

## Have you ever sat in Church and looked

**around**, not fully understanding all the vessels, vestments, and articles surrounding you? Or worse, sat there wanting to know more but not knowing where to go or whom to ask?

As we begin to understand what the items are and why they are relevant, we can start to appreciate the beauty and depth of our Catholic Faith. The aim is to get to know the sacred items so that Mass can be a deeper and richer experience. These are taken from The Sacred that Surrounds Us by Andrea Zachman Ascension Press.

#### THE THREE HOLY OILS

The three holy oils are sacred chrism, the oil of the catechumens, and the oil of the infirm. Chrism, the most important of the three holy oils, is used during baptism, confirmation, and holy orders and to consecrate a church.

The holy oils are stored in vessels called stocks and placed in an ambry until they are needed in the sacramental rites. Chrism consecrates the persons or objects, setting them apart for God. The oil of catechumens is used at the celebration of the sacrament of baptism to strengthen the person receiving baptism. The oil of the infirm is used during the anointing of the sick or dying and was first mentioned by Jesus, then by the apostles and their successors.




