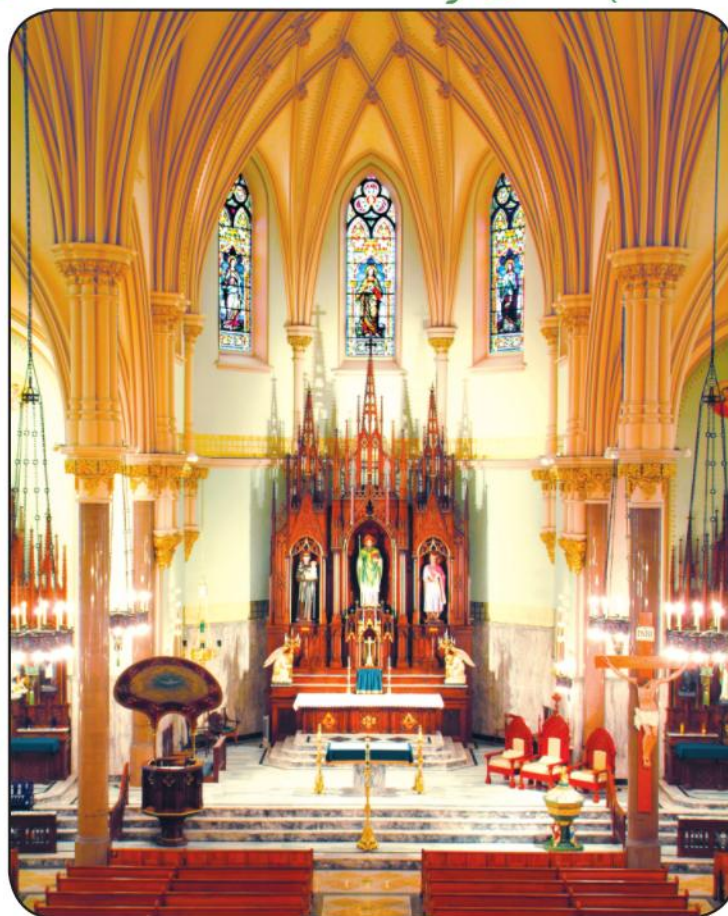

Dear People of God,

Ah, Thanksgiving! It'll soon be upon us! Two days off work, two days of stuffing ourselves after we stuff the turkey! The aroma of pumpkin pie! Four happy days of football for the sports fans and shopping for the shoppers in the family. However, as you take time to celebrate all the good things for which you can give thanks, keep in mind that we Catholics celebrate Thanksgiving far more than does the United States or any other nation. Our Mass, called the Eucharist, is always Thanksgiving; the word *Eucharist* itself is a Greek term which means *thanksgiving*. As a pastor I often take time to pray for specific things, among them giving thanks for the parish and its many ministries, its wonderful people and the kindnesses shown by our tremendous volunteers without whom we couldn't accomplish half of what we do. However, I also give thought to the interesting conjunction of major needs and the unexpected kindnesses of those who have remembered the parish in their wills. Large bequests seem to arrive just when they are most needed to address significant projects which the parish could not otherwise afford. The parish has in the past inherited a sum just enough to cover payroll when the weekly collections fell short, to patch the roof when it sprung an unexpected leak, to complete a renovation.

Some bequests are large, others small, all are much appreciated and go far toward the famous "bottom line." I often pray that those of us who can today afford to leave a bequest for the parish, large or small, will do so. I like to envision some future pastor also having the opportunity to give thanks that he and his councils can address other big ticket repairs and improvements when a bequest arrives "just in the nick of time." I know that many of us will see our estate dwindle away to cover the cost of old age (my mother's care in the last years of her life drained her estate so that each of us six kids got \$250 from her will), but if we stipulate in a will that the parish becomes one of our beneficiaries, we can continue to be supporters even after we've gone on ahead to the Kingdom and no longer have need of whatever might remain of our accumulated or depleted wealth. Please seriously consider mentioning the parish in your will and, as I've said before, if you don't have a will, take time to compose one so you decide what happens to the house, property and savings rather than some court-appointed administrator who may have no idea at all of your own preferences.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Nadine Furey, one of our parishioners, is an adoption assessor and works for Lucas County Probate Court and for Caring for Kids foster and adoption agency located in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio.

If you have any questions about adoption, Nadine could be helpful as she has over 30 years of experience in the adoption field. Nadine completes adoption homestudies and works with birth parents choosing an adoption plan. She works for Lucas County Probate Court with stepparent adoptions, relative adoptions, and independent adoptions. She also does minor Guardianship home studies and works with birth parents wanting an adoption plan. Nadine's work with Caring for Kids Foster and Adoption agency consists of completing adoptive homestudies for people wanting to adopt infants and working with birth parents choosing an adoption plan.
