

Dear People of God,

I am sure most of you have heard that Jeff Gralak has discerned that at this time in his life, continuing the Deaconate Formation Process is no longer a viable plan of action. Discernment is never an easy project and I laud Jeff for his willingness to respond positively to this development in doing God's will. I offer my heartfelt thanks to Jeff for giving it "the old school try." As a typical greedy and selfish pastor, though, I have to admit that I am actually openly pleased that discernment has left Jeff free to continue to serve the Historic Church of St. Patrick and Immaculate Conception.

The current trend in Deacon Formation is to assign deacons to a parish where they are requested/needed. With two great deacons already assigned to our parish, the likelihood of Jeff being sent elsewhere was very high. I can honestly admit that I can stop plotting on how to keep him and his many talents and gifts for ministry here where we can make good use of them.

I mentioned last week that Pope Francis has asked all to grow in our own understanding and love of The Word. I'm sure all of us who have listened to Fr. Rudi's homilies are aware of God's great love for us as sinners whom God made as lovable. Father's message is rooted in the writings and ministry of St. Francis de Sales (secondary patron of our diocese) and I would invite all of us to make dood use of Formed (access information is in today's bulletin) to look up resources on St. Francis de Sales - perhaps a video to stream or an audio or even a text copy of his writings to expand on Fr. Rudi's homilies so we can truly embrace God's and in Jesus Christ God's love love so wondrously poured out on each of us. We live in a world that has in large measure forgotten God's love; we need to know it, appreciate it and share it to restore the peace and tranguility which is God's will for all people.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults</u>: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
