

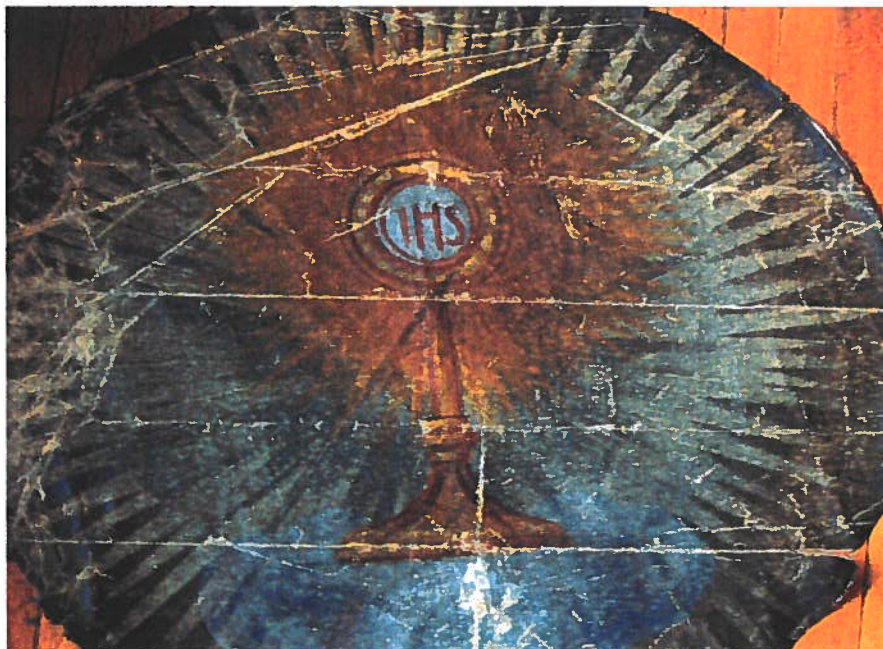


Remaking the Historical Face of the Historic Church of St. Patrick

Among the treasures of the parish are two thirty-six inch canvas roundels removed from the first St. Patrick's church. Over the years they were exposed to candle wax and soot, dust, and other natural air-borne debris. After they were rescued from the old building, they suffered further damage from careless storage and handling. They show their 157 years old age.

As the premier history-minded parish in Toledo, we'd like to see them restored to their original grandeur; however, the restoration, mounting, matting and framing so they can be displayed along side the four evangelist roundels on the choir loft rail call for generous sponsors, some of whom may be particularly tradition-oriented, historically motivated, or artistically appreciative. We also have parishioners and friends who value enhancing the well-known beauty and significance of the church in meaningful ways such as this project would do. The estimate for complete restoration is \$2000 for each historic artwork.
