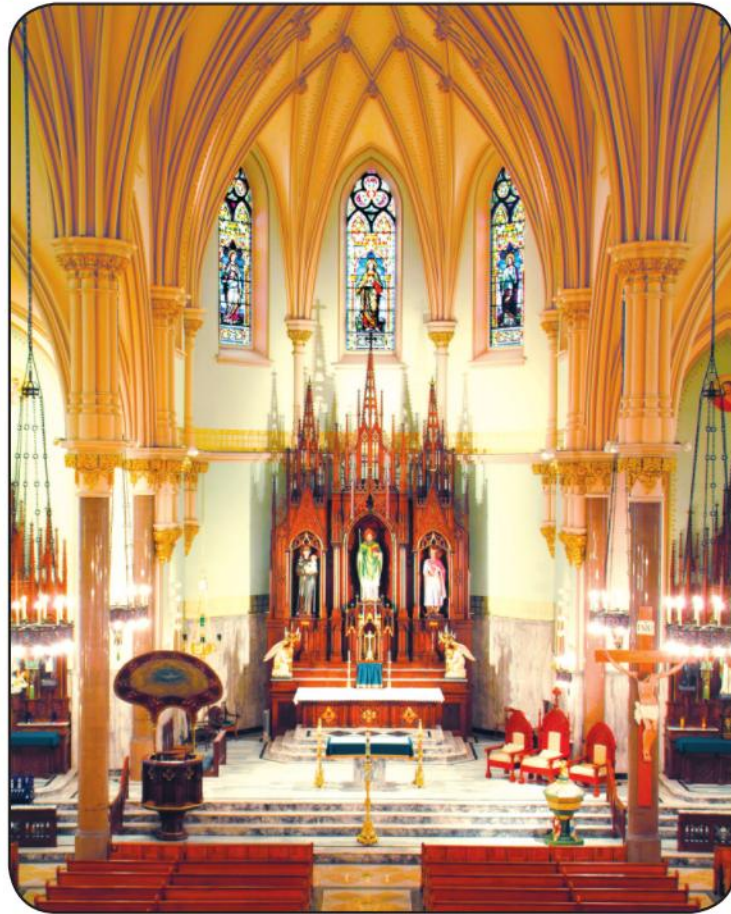

Dear People of God,

Today I want to offer my sincere thanks to all who have been so supportive of the parish through the lockdown occasioned by Covid-19. I know that the suppression of business led to many losing their jobs, perhaps for a time and perhaps forever. As you may know, I was among that group. As Judicial Vicar for the Diocese of Toledo, my salary was paid by the good people who support the ACA, many of them right here in the parish. When the shut downs began, I was asked to take (and did) a 20% cut in pay. As the pandemic continued to hold down our economy, I was asked to give up my diocesan position because the diocese could not afford to have me working at the Pastoral Center. I lost a job I really enjoyed doing and believe I did well in a Ministry of healing for men and women across the diocese. The Diocesan Tribunal had to sacrifice 40% of its staff and that meant the remaining people working on behalf of those seeking services, people whose lives now became more stressful and even more difficult. As I have been praying for those affected by the economic fallout from Covid-19, I now ask that you pray for the diocese and the Pastoral Center. I ask that you continue your generous support of the ACA and that others will join in that same support so that the ministerial services provided by the Center might continue to assist our people and parishes in their spiritual growth.

Of course, losing my position at the diocese means the parish will no longer be provided pastoral leadership for free. Over the years of my serving as Pastor, I have cautioned the Finance Council that this day was coming. I did not expect it quite so soon, but Coronavirus has had a way of making us face some huge changes. Assuming the responsibility for a pastor will not be a small undertaking for the parish despite the fact that the clergy are not paid what anyone would consider a handsome salary. As so often happens, it's the benefits package and health insurance that tends to drive the high cost of having a pastor on the payroll. Thanks to the generosity of many of our parishioners, I believe we're in a good position to weather this significant challenge. Those who support the parish regularly have been extremely kind and wonderfully generous, even at the height of the pandemic economic downturn. However, there are many who do little or nothing to assist with the bills we face and I urge them to prayerfully consider what they can do to join that all-important Ministry of giving.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

With the changes required by the Diocese of Toledo, the role of Liturgical Ministers will be different at our Masses for a while. Eucharistic Ministers will **not** be utilized as Communion will only be the Body of Christ and distributed by the priest and deacon. We will not have a choir, there will be no acolytes and no hospitality after Mass.

There are still ways to answer God's call to ministry, though. Please consider trying a new role at Mass. Once we have the names of the people willing to participate, a new schedule will be created and mailed.

Liturgical Ministers during COVID-19

Lector – We still need proclaimers of the Word at both the 8 a.m. Mass and 10 a.m. Mass on Sunday mornings. We will happily train anyone interested in serving as lectors who have not read at Mass before.

What to know:

Lectors must be age 65 or younger to be on the altar, or willing to sign a waiver

Lectors may read both readings and the stanzas of the psalm

If there are two lectors for Mass, there will be six feet of separation between the seats for proper social distancing

Lectors will receive Holy Communion on the altar

Ushers – We need ushers to help dismiss parishioners at the end of Mass to receive Holy Communion before exiting the church. We will provide training for anyone new to the role of usher at HSP.

What to know:

All ushers must wear masks

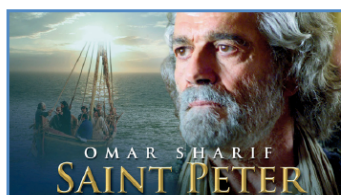

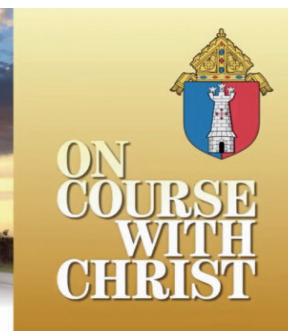
