

Dear People of God,

Advent in the age of Pandemic is different than Advents of the past. Today we are in much the same mode as were the people of the ancient world waiting impatiently for salvation. I've even heard a few people put it in those words: we need to be saved from the pandemic.

For thousands of years, the people of the Bible were awaiting salvation but it wasn't from some earthly event or disaster but from themselves, from their sin and from failing to intuit and then worship the great God of creation. It took a while but it's evident from the Bible that humanity slowly but surely came to accept responsibility for its own fall, to accept that personal sin damaged self, community and the world. Once that realization hit home, those ancient people began to recognize that a loving God would come to their assistance, save them from themselves, and save them from their sins. For we Christians Advent is a recollection of that period of longing for the savior to come. Of course we know that salvation did arrive in the person of Jesus the Christ. Our Advent is a memory, not a reality of the deep, heart-felt longing of people aware of the need for the gift of what Jesus alone gives.

While the salivation for which we currently long is nowhere near as deeply felt, or as ancient as that of the people of the Bible, perhaps we can get a sense of what those millennia of waiting were like. Perhaps we can come to the same conclusion as did the people of the Bible: the answer lies with God. As a person of faith, I trust that it will be God who reveals the ultimate way to defeat the coronavirus. Yes, God will make use of human talents and abilities to do it (that's why he gives us gifts and talents), but it will be the work of God to intervene to make that end possible.

I would urge all of us to make use of the remaining days of Advent to do what the people of the Bible did for thousands of years: beseech God for the answers, the gifts, the love which will put an end to this time of waiting and suffering.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Liturgical Ministry Update

With the changes required by the Diocese of Toledo, the role of Liturgical Ministers will be different at our Masses for a while. Eucharistic Ministers will **not** be utilized as Communion will only be the Body of Christ and distributed by the priest and deacon. We will not have a choir, there will be no acolvtes and no hospitality after Mass.

There are still ways to answer God's call to ministry, though. Please consider trying a new role at Mass. Once we have the names of the people willing to participate, a new schedule will be created and mailed.

Liturgical Ministers during COVID-19

Lector – We still need proclaimers of the Word at both the 8 a.m. Mass and 10 a.m. Mass on Sunday mornings. We will happily train anyone interested in serving as lectors who have not read at Mass before.

What to know:

Lectors must be age 65 or younger to be on the altar, or willing to sign a waiver

Lectors may read both readings and the stanzas of the psalm

If there are two lectors for Mass, there will be six feet of separation between the seats for proper social distancing

Lectors will receive Holy Communion on the altar

Ushers – We need ushers to help dismiss parishioners at the end of Mass to receive Holy Communion before exiting the church. We will provide training for anyone new to the role of usher at HSP.

What to know:

All ushers must wear masks


