

### Dear People of God,

It's with a heavy heart that I announce the retirement of our beloved Deacon Tom. After many vears of service as a staff member of the parish. drawn here from his teaching position at St. Anne's by the arrival of his nephew Rev. Msgr. Michael Billian, Tom has given the parish over twenty years of faithful and dedicated service. both as a diaconal minister and as a member of the staff working to build up the ministries, especially the Outreach Program of the parish. However, recent health related issues and a decision to turn in the keys to his car have led Tom to decide that it's time to lay down the baton and end the race. As Pastor I have accepted his resignation from the paid staff position. I offer the prayerful support of the entire parish as he moves on to whatever God now has in store. I hope you will join with me in that sentiment.

Tom's time here at the parish has seen him interact with hundreds of couples planning a wedding, with moms and dads preparing for the baptism of their children and with families grieving the loss of a beloved family member. Several couples who celebrated their marriage with him have also had their children baptized by Deacon Tom. These diaconal duties will remain, as well as his presence at the Altar.

The Deacon will be best remembered for his role in growing and consolidating the food pantry and other outreach programs here at the parish, lending to the naming of the pantry at Historic St. Patrick in his honor. Over the years thousands of men and women, young and old, have been served by the pantry, with services for displaced travelers and other means of helping the needy in our midst. Tom will continue to be an excellent role model for what it means to truly love our neighbor as we love ourselves. As Pastor I pray there will continue to be others who take up the volunteer road and follow in Tom's footsteps of service, compassion and care.

### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

There are still ways to answer God's call to ministry, though. Please consider trying a new role at Mass. Once we have the names of the people willing to participate, a new schedule will be created and mailed.

### Liturgical Ministers during COVID-19

**Lector** – We still need proclaimers of the Word at both the 8 a.m. Mass and 10 a.m. Mass on Sunday mornings. We will happily train anyone interested in serving as lectors who have not read at Mass before.

### What to know:

Lectors must be age 65 or younger to be on the altar, or willing to sign a waiver

Lectors may read both readings and the stanzas of the psalm

If there are two lectors for Mass, there will be six feet of separation between the seats for proper social distancing

Lectors will receive Holy Communion on the altar

**Ushers** – We need ushers to help dismiss parishioners at the end of Mass to receive Holy Communion before exiting the church. We will provide training for anyone new to the role of usher at HSP.

# Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency

during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio, or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or

school events in that geographic region are also cancelled.

### Health News from the Parish Nurse for January 10, 2021

Facts about COVID-19 Vaccines: COVID-19 vaccines will not cause you to test positive on COVID-19 viral tests.

Neither the recently authorized and recommended vaccines nor the other COVID-19 vaccines currently in clinical trials in the United States cause you to test positive on viral tests, which are used to see if you have a current infection. If your body develops an immune response. which is the goal of vaccination, there is a possibility you may test positive on some antibody tests. Antibody tests indicate you had a previous infection and that you may have some level of protection against the virus. Experts are currently looking at how COVID-19 vaccination may affect antibody testing results. 
