

Dear People of God,

I was reading an article the other day that should make all of us here at the Historic Church of St. Patrick take even greater pride in our Irish heritage. The title was "Brendan: Did He Really Arrive First in America?"

Brendan the Navigator, one of several Irish saints named Brendan, was born in 484, shortly after the Patron of the Emerald Isle died; he was raised by staunch Christians who passed on their love of the Church to Brendan. He entered the monastery and found it agreeable, so much so that he established several other monastic houses around the island and in Scotland. The monasteries were at the forefront of education back then (we're talking around the year 500, half a millennium before the first universities were founded, also by monks) and Brendan was somewhat a Renaissance Man whose interests ranged from theology to biology, from the mysteries of the earth to the mysteries of the skies. A natural scientist, he was well aware that the earth was not a flat surface but understood the science of the ancients who had proved that the earth was a globe. His interest in that globe led him to embark on a number of voyages to learn what he could about the mechanisms which kept us all on board.

The most famous of these voyages took him and a few other brave monks out into the Atlantic to discover what other islands might exist out there beyond the horizon. His voyage was recorded with exacting detail that has helped modern explorers better grasp the breadth of his wanderings. Geographical and botanical entries suggest he had visited the Canary Islands using his boat of wood staves and leather siding and may well have landed in the Bahamian Archipelago a half millennium before Eric the Red supposedly traveled to Vineland and a thousand years before Columbus made his own voyages of discovery. In fact, contemporary adventurers built a boat from wood and leather, following the design outlined in the records of Brendan's travels and, using the prevailing winds and currents, sailed the boat to Newfoundland! After their own voyage these stalwart sailors speculated that Brendan's voyage took him to North America around the year 565 giving Ireland the credit for "discovering" the new world and certainly earning Brendan his title "The Navigator."

Here's a Brendan fact to conclude these facts from his impressive life: From the time of his death until the nineteenth century, Brendan was by far the best known Irish saint, outpacing even Patrick in that role.

### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

### Liturgical Ministers during COVID-19

**Lector** – We still need proclaimers of the Word at both the 8 a.m. Mass and 10 a.m. Mass on Sunday mornings. We will happily train anyone interested in serving as lectors who have not read at Mass before.

### What to know:

Lectors must be age 65 or younger to be on the altar, or willing to sign a waiver

Lectors may read both readings and the stanzas of the psalm

If there are two lectors for Mass, there will be six feet of separation between the seats for proper social distancing

Lectors will receive Holy Communion on the altar

**Ushers** – We need ushers to help dismiss parishioners at the end of Mass to receive Holy Communion before exiting the church. We will provide training for anyone new to the role of usher at HSP.

Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio, or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or

school events in that geographic region are also cancelled.
