

Dear People of God,

It is once again time to consider the Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA), the opportunity we all have to assist in the larger sense of Ministry in the Diocese. I invite your serious consideration of a gift this year, either a one-time offering or something spaced out over the coming year.

You can learn about the ACA on YouTube: the Bishop and Senior Staff have put together a video which highlights the major areas where the ACA provides funding for programs and efforts none of us could support on our own. Search YouTube on your computer or open the app on your phone or tablet and then search the site for the 2021 Toledo Diocese Annual Catholic Appeal. It's a really nice overview of what your ACA dollars are doing for God's people throughout the nineteen counties of the diocese.

Of course, one of the areas where a lot of dollars are being spent is in the preparation of the priests and deacons who will be serving you as pastor or assistant over the years to come. I would guess that no single parish in this diocese could afford on its own to provide for the education of its next pastor or a deacon to assist with the service ministries of the parish. All of us working together can meet that pressing need.



The department which assists the parishes with evangelization and technology also gets its funding from the ACA. The people there are working with pastors and staff to implement a variety of internet-supported platforms which offer training, educational opportunities and ministry guidance. Help is available with strategic planning and recruitment of parishioners to work with evangelization programs at the parish level.

The Discipleship and Family Life Office assists with premarital preparation via the PreCana process for couples seeking marriage, with second marriage counseling, and marriage enrichment programs. The office maintains a referral department to work with couples having problems in their marriage. The Diocesan Divorced and Separated program is monitored and assisted from this same office.

Other important programs include intercultural ministries serving the specific communities resident in our diocese, Youth and Young Adult programs for parishes, schools and colleges, the Teens Encounter Christ process, and the Diocesan Scouting Chaplain. Catholic schools also receive support and training from the ACA and the ACA helps fund the two diocesan elementary schools: Cathedral and Queen of Apostles.

Please consider a donation to these worthwhile efforts to work together as one to make the work of Jesus happen.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

With the changes required by the Diocese of Toledo, the role of Liturgical Ministers will be different at our Masses for a while. Eucharistic Ministers will **not** be utilized as Communion will only be the Body of Christ and distributed by the priest and deacon. We will not have a choir, there will be no acolytes and no hospitality after Mass.

There are still ways to answer God's call to ministry, though. Please consider trying a new role at Mass. Once we have the names of the people willing to participate, a new schedule will be created and mailed.

Liturgical Ministers during COVID-19

Lector – We still need proclaimers of the Word at both the 8 a.m. Mass and 10 a.m. Mass on Sunday mornings. We will happily train anyone interested in serving as lectors who have not read at Mass before.

What to know:

Lectors must be age 65 or younger to be on the altar, or willing to sign a waiver

Lectors may read both readings and the stanzas of the psalm

If there are two lectors for Mass, there will be six feet of separation between the seats for proper social distancing

Lectors will receive Holy Communion on the altar

Ushers – We need ushers to help dismiss parishioners at the end of Mass to receive Holy Communion before exiting the church. We will provide training for anyone new to the role of usher at HSP.

What to know:

All ushers must wear masks

Happenings at the Parish!

Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a *Level 3 Snow Emergency*

during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio, or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or school events in that geographic region are also cancelled.
