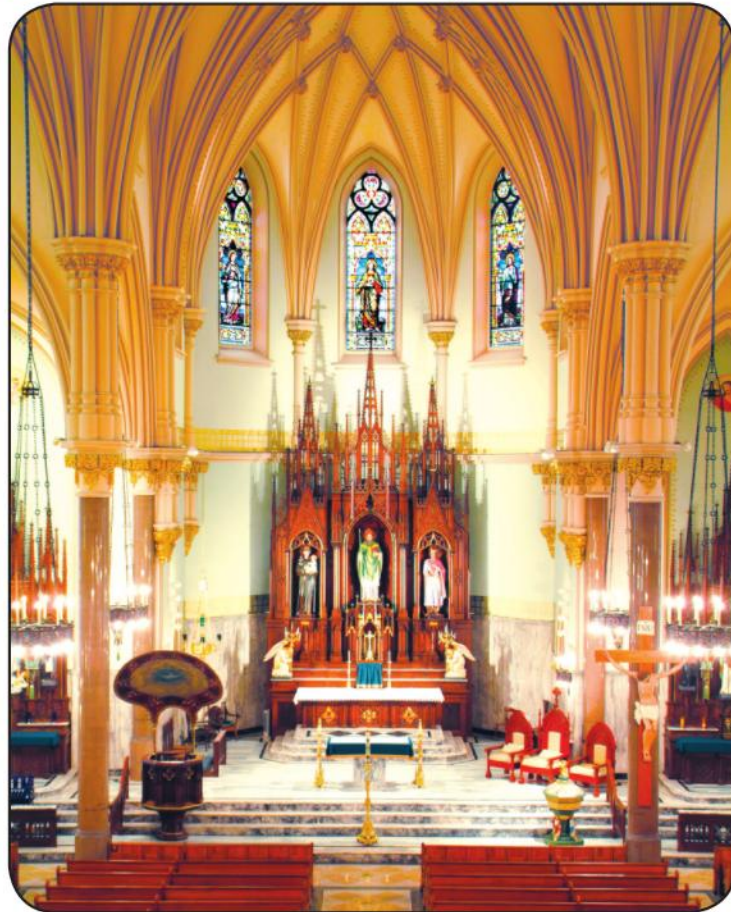

Dear People of God

Welcome to the annual celebration of the patronal feast day. As the premier Irish destination parish in Northwest Ohio, we're always excited to welcome guests, friends and parishioners to the church dedicated to the great saint of Ireland.

Patrick was truly a man of faith, a man who never lost his trust in a saving God despite having been taken away to Ireland as a slave. Despite the privations encountered while serving his master, he came to love the land and people of the Emerald Isle and after gaining his freedom, he returned to the island to begin the serious work of bringing the Good News of Jesus Christ to the high and the mighty and the lowest of the low. He did not have to go to Ireland, you know. His career in the Church offered the chance to travel to Rome and find his place in the very center of Christendom. He rejected that opportunity in favor of becoming a missionary and his greater place in history was thus assured.

Patrick left behind a wealth of writing, a rare ability in his age when most men and women had no idea what pen and paper were, let alone the mystery of the figures on a sheet which conveyed meaning and insight. Among the works he crafted was the binding prayer often referred to as the Breastplate of St. Patrick. In it he laid out the love of Trinity and Unity found in the reality of his God, the God who loved him and loved the people of Ireland.

As contemporary "Irish," whether we hail from the Emerald Isle, are descended from the Celts, or simply relate to the Church via this wonderful old parish, Patrick's love of God should serve as a powerful model for our own relationship with God and with God's people. Imitating Patrick, let us strive to be missionaries, bringing the Word of God to all we meet, living a life dedicated to that same amazing Jesus Patrick so much loved. Enjoy this day, this liturgy and the traditions and excellence of Ireland.

### ***The Celebration of Sacraments***

**Infant Baptism:** The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance:** The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony:** Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

With the changes required by the Diocese of Toledo, the role of Liturgical Ministers will be different at our Masses for a while. Eucharistic Ministers will **not** be utilized as Communion will only be the Body of Christ and distributed by the priest and deacon. We will not have a choir, there will be no acolytes and no hospitality after Mass.

There are still ways to answer God's call to ministry, though. Please consider trying a new role at Mass. Once we have the names of the people willing to participate, a new schedule will be created and mailed.

**Liturgical Ministers during COVID-19**

**Lector** – We still need proclaimers of the Word at both the 8 a.m. Mass and 10 a.m. Mass on Sunday mornings. We will happily train anyone interested in serving as lectors who have not read at Mass before.

**What to know:**

Lectors must be age 65 or younger to be on the altar, or willing to sign a waiver

Lectors may read both readings and the stanzas of the psalm

If there are two lectors for Mass, there will be six feet of separation between the seats for proper social distancing

Lectors will receive Holy Communion on the altar

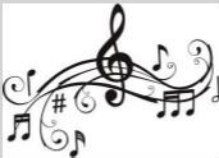
