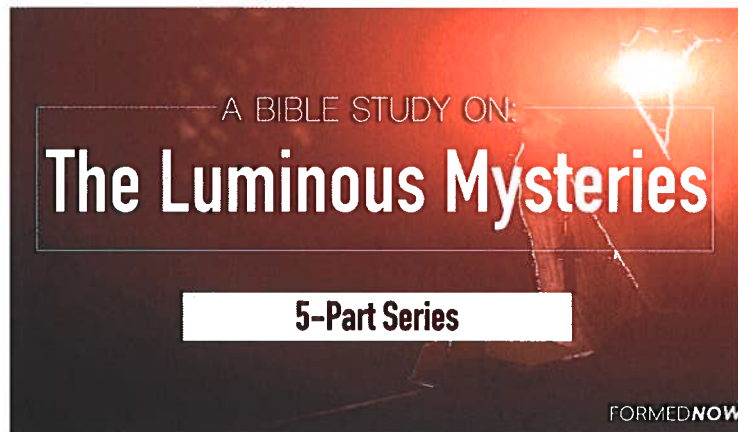

A BIBLE STUDY ON THE LUMINOUS MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY

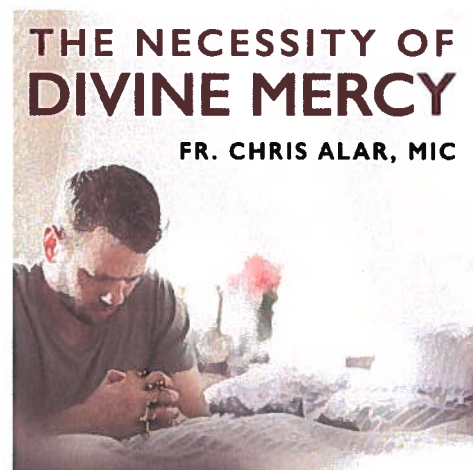
