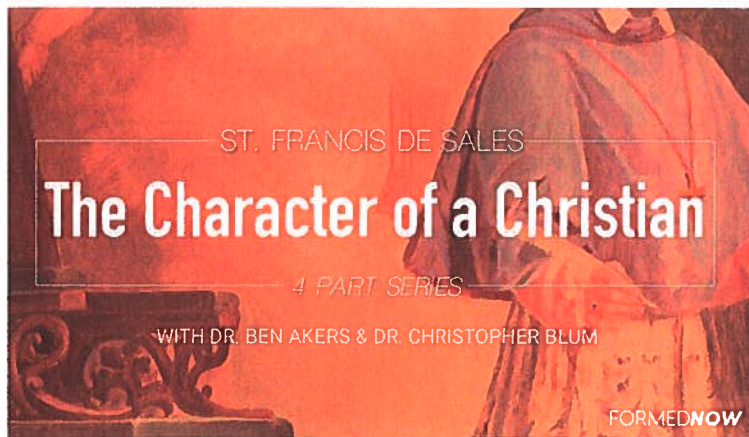
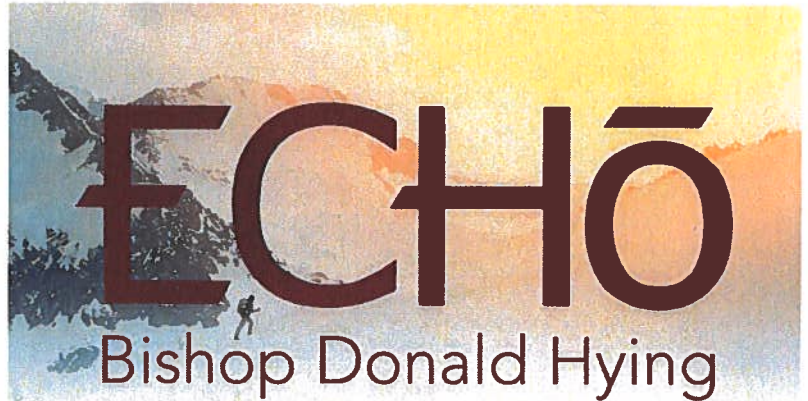

ST. FRANCIS DE SALES AND THE CHARACTER OF A CHRISTIAN

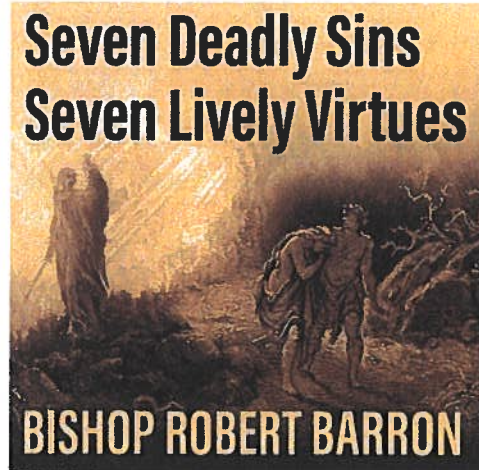


