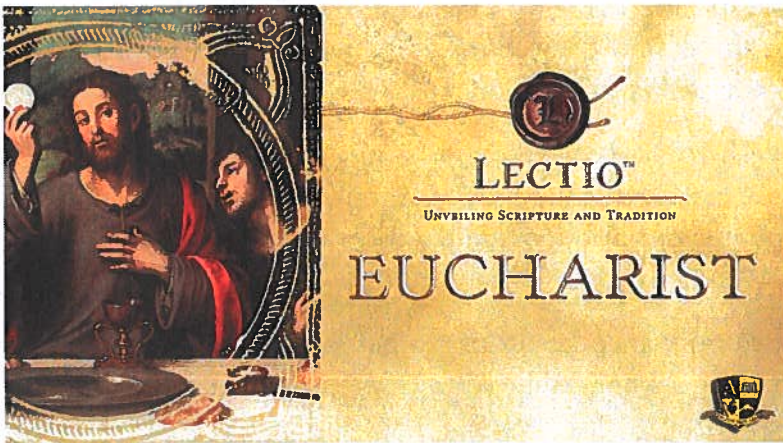
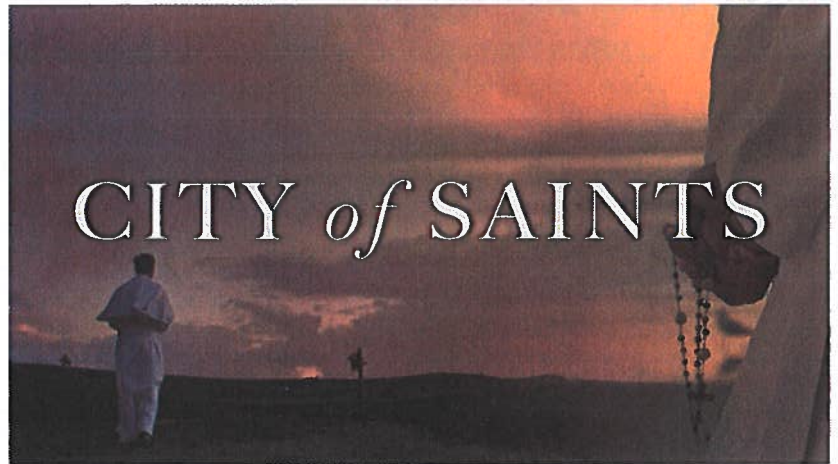

LECTIO: EUCHARIST WITH DR. BRANT PITRE

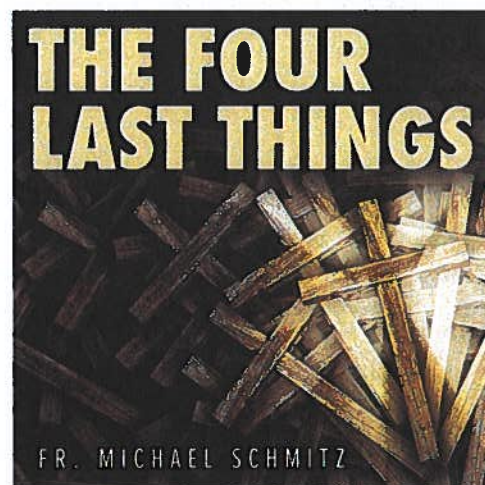
