

Dear Friends, Visitors and Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the annual Blue Mass, a time of prayerful support for the men and women who daily take up the task of keeping the peace so that we might all rest comfortably knowing we are safe. Here at the Historic Church of St. Patrick, we pause to reflect on the sacrifices made by those whom we honor today. We equally take pause to pray for the repose of the souls of those who did, in fact, risk all and to pray for their families and loved ones.

Perhaps many of us here today are unaware that the city has erected a memorial plaza located near the Safety Building which commemorates all those who, over the years, have stood bravely "on the line" so that we don't have to. The plaza includes the large plaque illustrated above as well as memorial stones for each officer killed in action. There's a wonderfully poignant statuary memorial there easily accessed from the Orange Street side of the plaza.

As we gather today to pray for and with our peacekeepers from several different jurisdictions, we might want to take a trip over to the memorial plaza and quietly reflect on the good men and women who serve us so diligently. We might also wish to go over to the Peace Officers' Shrine area and take a look at the binder there which lists the names of the far too many men and women who have died in the line of duty just this year. It's a commentary on the risk and the sacrifice which draws us together today in prayer.

Thanks to all who have joined us today and to all of the Peace Officers who could not join us: you are all in our prayers, not just today but every time we gather in this sacred space to offer praise and adoration to the God who loves all and watches over all. May God protect you and return you safely to your family, friend and co-workers.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Eucharistic Ministers will **not** be utilized as Communion will only be the Body of Christ and distributed by the priest and deacon. We will not have a choir, there will be no acolvtes and no hospitality after Mass.

There are still ways to answer God's call to ministry, though. Please consider trying a new role at Mass. Once we have the names of the people willing to participate, a new schedule will be created and mailed.

Liturgical Ministers during COVID-19

Lector – We still need proclaimers of the Word at both the 8 a.m. Mass and 10 a.m. Mass on Sunday mornings. We will happily train anyone interested in serving as lectors who have not read at Mass before.

What to know:

Lectors must be age 65 or younger to be on the altar, or willing to sign a waiver

Lectors may read both readings and the stanzas of the psalm

If there are two lectors for Mass, there will be six feet of separation between the seats for proper social distancing

Lectors will receive Holy Communion on the altar

Ushers – We need ushers to help dismiss parishioners at the end of Mass to receive Holy Communion before exiting the church. We will provide training for anyone new to the role of usher at HSP.

What to know:

All ushers must wear masks
