

Dear People of God,

Someone mentioned the other day that it seemed odd that the Diocese was selling its low income housing units. Shouldn't the Church be about helping those in need? In fact, what to do with the low income developments had been an ongoing issue for some time. Back in the 60's and 70's when the Church acquired its first such property, it seemed a great idea to begin a Ministry to the under and unemployed by providing low cost housing in an atmosphere guided by the spiritual oversight of the Church. Over the years a number of sites were developed with the expectation of providing some spiritual guidance in addition to rent subsidy. Madonna Homes, Regina Homes, the Plaza reconfiguration and a few others were acquired and developed in hopes of assisting people with far more than rent subsidies in a nicely maintained building. A managerial structure was put together under the heading Mareda and things took off really well. Unfortunately, as so often occurs with great ideas, things then changed; from the point of view of the Church, most of the changes were not conducive to ministry.

Low income, subsidized housing came under government regulation. No one believes that the oversight wasn't a good idea, but because of the separation of Church and State, the role of the Church was instantly and greatly reduced until no real ministry was occurring; the spiritual welfare of the residents was off limits to the very Church which organized Mareda to provide that kind of ministry.

Still, because the diocese felt it was a ministry of charity to oversee the numerous units available, it continued to provide the regulated management structure required by the government. However, as regulatory restrictions grew, they generated a real quandary: should the diocese be in the rental business without at least some privilege to provide spiritual programming for the renters, at least on a voluntary basis?

By the time the decision was made to sell the Mareda properties, the diocese was little more than the absentee landlord with responsibilities for upkeep and maintenance and little else. Unable to do what had originally been intended and facing mounting costs to maintain the units in the condition the diocese wanted, it seemed the better part of valor to put these developments into the hands of better qualified and competent managers accustomed to working with the government's regulatory agencies.

It was not an easy decision but after months of negotiation, the diocese found an organization which met its strict standards for the care and supervision of the developments so that the dignity of the renters would be assured. Funds realized from the sale were directed toward similar ministerial programming.

#### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




