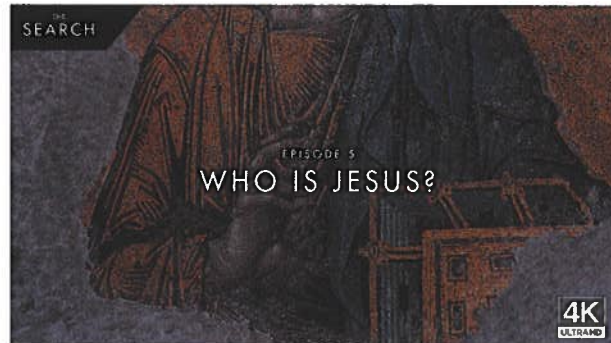

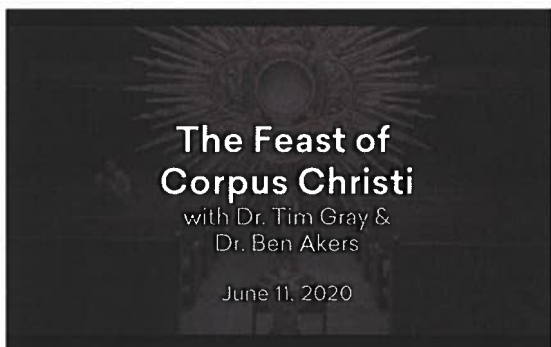
THE SEARCH: EPISODE 5 - WHO IS JESUS?

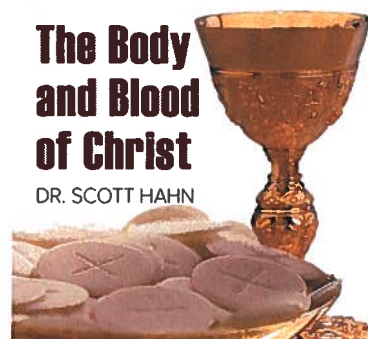

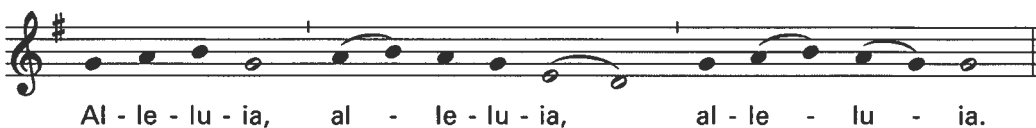

SYMBOL OF FAITH—THE NICENE CREED
