



Dear People of God,

I have mentioned Intentional Planning a couple of times and want to keep you updated. The initial phase of the process is about to begin. The St. Teresa of Calcutta Deanery, of which we are a part, will be joining in discussion about the future with the St. Agnes Deanery to our north and west. By way of recollection, there are nineteen parishes in this constellation.

They are as follows:

These constitute the better part of the parishes in Toledo. There is one on the east side and another six across the outer fringe of the city. most of which include parts of other municipalities. The outward movement of Catholics to the more distant suburbs and the resulting aging population of many of the parishes in our discussion zone will no doubt be a serious consideration as we look forward with intentionality to the future of the city's Catholic houses of worship. Other concerns are the lack of clergy to provide sacramental services and the consequential necessity of lay administration to handle daily mission and ministry. Currently one parish in the above is headed by a lay Administrator. Delegates from each parish and institution (our Deanery also includes Central Catholic High School, St Francis Chapel/Outreach and the Pastoral Center) will shortly be gathering to get a good overview of the zone, its configuration today and the demographic forecasts for the future. Stay tuned for further updates.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
