

### Dear People of God,

Welcome to the annual Historic Church of St. Patrick celebration of regional and now even international fire fighters, EMTs and Paramedics. As we pause to remember the events of 9-11 and the sad days of recovery following the terrorist attacks, we also make note of the forty-first anniversary of the tower fire here at Historic St. Pat's in September of 1980. The pages of human history are splattered with tragic events, from the time when Cain killed Abel over a religious dispute even into our own times when religion continues to foster deeply seated hatreds rather than the peace God intends any religion to foster. Our gathering in the tranquil environment of the Historic Church of St. Patrick reminds us that the real purpose of religion is to reveal a God of love, compassion and care, a provident God who calls us to "love one another as I have loved you." Certainly those who enter into the realm of fighting fire and serving the needs of injured and sick speak to the very best of what religion demands, the risk of sacrifice for the good of those whom we serve. Firefighters, EMTs and Paramedics regularly face the ultimate risk of life itself in order to perform their manifold duties; for this we give thanks and take time to celebrate.

We also take time, I hope, to be about the business of maintaining our homes, offices and places of business in such a way that fire and accidents do not occur so that we do not become responsible for the untimely injury or worse of those dispatched to render us assistance. Smoke detectors and regular checking of those batteries, keeping trash in its appointed place, and having a home safety plan are great ways to both prevent fire and to make sure if one does take hold, we can get away to call the department. A couple of decades ago there was a familiar refrain among the young: WWJD (What Would Jesus Do?). I believe Jesus would ask us to take care of our place in the world, protect ourselves and our property against fire, and minimize the risks of fire for neighbors and community. It's all part of loving our neighbor as we love ourselves but more importantly, loving God above all things

We are reminded that firefighters are on the line today, battling forest fires and standing ready to protect property and lives. They are in our prayers.

## The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




