Dear People of God,

Over the past couple of years, it has been gratifying to see so many men and women take part in Bible Study and the related programs being offered here at the Historic Church of St. Patrick, many of them taking advantage of the wealth of information made available to us via FORMED. I'd like to invite everyone, young and old, male and female, to consider becoming part of the ongoing studies. They are a pleasant way to grow in the faith and share it among those fellow travelers on the pilgrimage to the Kingdom and a great way to acquire the background so we can defend our Church among those not of it.

A big part of our Baptismal obligation to "know, love and serve God in this life" is to study and learn all we can about God and God's plans for the world and for each of us. Continuing growth in knowledge prevents us from misunderstanding the teachings of the Church or getting the false idea that we know more than the Church does because of some article we find on the internet which has no real roots in our faith.

In general, I avoid the internet for my religious studies other than to go to the Vatican web page to read the latest from the Holy Father and other official sources in the Church. I've been shown printouts by a number of parishioners from some of the so-called "best" pages on the web and find them to contain serious errors and perhaps even what we used to call heresy or false teaching.

For those who still like turning the pages of a good book, Reger's here in Toledo is a great source for a wide variety of Catholic religious and theological works. You can go on-line to the Pauline Book Center in Washington DC and even Barnes and Noble at CUA (Catholic University of America) to find rock solid books to dive into. Our own little parish library or the library at Lourdes College are other nearby and helpful resources but please, take a look at FORMED if you haven't already done so and take advantage of the generosity of someone here in the diocese.

#### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

<u>Matrimony</u>: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
