



Dear People of God,

From time to time I like to offer a bit of Irish history so all of us, Irish by birth or by choice, can properly boast of our heritage. In the west transept up near the top are four Irish saints: Patrick, Brendan, Bridget and Coluimcille (Columba). This last is perhaps



the most famous historical figure in the Irish Church. He was an O'Niel of Donegal in 521 and was first on the list to assume the clan leadership of Ulster and rise to become High King of Ireland. However, rather than politics, he chose religion and entered the Catholic clergy. Perhaps this

was a penance because his great grandfather was the clan chief who kidnapped Patrick and brought him to Ireland!

In his era the Church meant a monastic order and Columba joined the Benedictines; like many an Irish Monk, he moved through Ireland founding houses of the Order. The most famous is that at Kells where the famous Book of Kells (displayed at Trinity College in Dublin) was completed. As an O'Neil he now and again intervened in Irish politics to resolve issues between the clans. He was a Bardic scholar, preserving the cultural heritage of the earliest Gaelic clans on the Emerald Isle and convincing the clan leaders to support this intervention, many of whom were anxious to modernize and become more European as immigrants from mainland Europe began to filter onto the island.

Coluimcille made his way to Scotland and established a deeply rooted Catholic and Irish influence which eventually allowed the Gaels to all but replace the native Picts. He founded the monastery at Iona and made it his missionary headquarters. He is considered the first saint of Scotland and revered in England as well. Coluimcille founded a school at Derry and considered this town the site of his favorite Irish foundation. With a great love of Ireland, he prepared a series of commentaries which laid out the history of Ireland. It was republished in English in 1969, edited by Peter Bender. Coluimcille died in 597. The painting here is from St. Eunan's Cathedral, Letterkenny, County Done-gal, Ireland, not far from his beloved Derry.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults</u>: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




