

 Dear People of God,


Today marks the beginning of a new liturgical year. Advent comes to us from the Latin for a "coming to..." We're coming to the Lord as his faithful, anxious to recall the events of salvation history which begins with the period of watchful waiting we refer to as "Old Testament Times" or the four weeks of Advent. We're coming to the Christ, born in Bethlehem for our salvation; even as we come to that event, Jesus comes to us, historically as an infant and realistically as the source of life in the Church I hope we all love. Traditionally the four weeks of Advent represent the four thousand years you can count from Genesis through the period of the Kings and then the Prophets and finally to the birth of Jesus.

Stop and give thought to the fidelity of God's people who waited and waited and watched for four thousand long, difficult years. Then give thought to the impatience we typically show toward everything these days, whether for the driver in front of us to move forward as a light changes to green or the way we snarl at the wait staff if they don't refill the coffee cup fast enough. Waiting and watching is a talent all of us need to work on and the Church gives us that opportunity during these holy days of Advent. Do we really need to have the Christmas tree up now or could it wait a week or two so that we force ourselves to wait?

I've often wondered why we're in such a rush, and not just to stay ahead of the various holidays. We rush through meals as if we actually had something vital to do afterward; I've eaten in enough Italian restaurants in Italy where a good meal takes at least two hours to know that nobody finishes up as quickly as we do at our favorite Italian spots here in Toledo. We rush to work and wonder why there are so many wrecks along the way, many of which may be because we're in a rush to text somebody about something totally unnecessary.

These four weeks of Advent invite us to slow down a little and savor the difference between what the Old Testament people could only hope for and the realty in which we live and breathe as Christians. We are asked to take time to contemplate the wonder of God's promise fulfilled in the days we commemorate after the Advent season comes to its end. So, slow down! Enjoy the quiet pace of the Advent season and allow yourself to experience the thrill of anticipation which comes from waiting. You might just find it satisfying and healthy for your soul and that of those whom you meet along the way.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

<u>Matrimony</u>: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Due to covid again this year we have moved the Open House to church to allow for proper social distancing. After Mass breakfast will be served by Manhattan's in the back of church.




