
Advent, a time of preparation. In many ways the season has been put on the back burner by the economic cycle which demands that merchandizers stay well ahead of any given season so that when the season arrives, we're all ready. In a sense that's secular preparation, a time to get ready by finding the things we need to make the season look, sound, feel and even smell appropriate (I'm writing this the day before Thanksgiving and the house already has the aromas associated with the day itself). Some of us start preparing beginning right after Christmas, buying at deeply reduced prices the decorations and other things we'll wonder where we put away next fall. Others no doubt already have the Christmas tree up and all the lights on around the yard. A few of us may complain about the big rush, but in any case, all of that activity reminds us how important it is to prepare, to plan ahead and be ready for what we know or expect is coming.

We do that a lot. Think of planning a back yard barb-que and who to invite, what to serve and what to do if it rains? Think of your 401K or other retirement investments. Think of the plot you already bought at the cemetery (well, I have, and even the tombstone) and the notes you left for loved ones about who gets the fine linen and the tableware.

Planning ahead, preparing, is a very human behavior. Understanding that behavior, the Church provides a time for preparation and spiritual planning ahead called Advent.

Our Advent preparation isn't supposed to focus on minor details like which corner should we put the tree in or how much rum goes into the egg nog without making it illegal; rather, our preparation is inward, in the soul as it embraces the truth of salvation. We're not just thinking of the birth of the savior but of all that his birth has accomplished in our individual lives. At Christmas we're supposed to know what it is God has accomplished for us; Advent gives us plenty of opportunity to think things through before we arrive at the festival day. By the way, thinking things through (meditation) is a form of prayer which opens us to the more important part of prayer called listening. Maybe God has something wonderful to say to you this year so take advantage.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

<u>Matrimony</u>: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Sunday, December 19



Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency

during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio, or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish,

or school events in that geographic region are also cancelled.




