

Dear People of God,

A visitor at a recent Mass marveled at the beauty and grandeur of our wonderful Historic Church of St. Patrick and asked who the four saints up above the Conversion of Ireland art glass window might be. Although the same images at Immaculate Conception were destroyed in the 1920 fire, for anyone familiar with Irish history, their identity is well-known: They are the four principal patrons of Ireland which is why they featured in the art glass at Immaculate and as well at Good Shepherd. Of Course, Patrick is there, the once-upon-a-time slave who returned to convert his captors/owners. Patrick considered himself a missionary so had no set place from which he ministered; rather he trekked the island from end to end, north to south and shared the Good News so exuberantly that he made numerous converts all across the Emerald Isle. A great role model for all of us here and now!

St. Bridget of Kildare was a Benedictine Sister, vowed to a life of poverty in service to others. She, like Patrick, was a missionary and once she had established a convent of sisters in one spot, she moved on to another, as anxious as the early disciples to see the Good News established and rooted in every corner of the world she knew. Thanks to a kind donor, St. Patrick's has a shrine honoring this Irish saint and the statue from Good Shepherd can be seen today in a classroom at St. Thomas..

Brendan, a Benedictine monk, was for a long time considered the primary patron of Ireland because he didn't stay home but traveled the world not only to share the Good News but to explore the unknown and let everybody know where he was from. His journal relates many of his travels as far south as Africa, through much of the known world and even to a land far to the west many believe was North America. Like Patrick and Bridget, he established a number of Benedictine houses so that the evangelization he began would continue.

The last of the four great Irish saints is Columba, another Benedictine monk whose greatest accomplishments were undertaken in mainland Europe rather than on the island. He transitioned fairly quickly to Scotland (where he remains the principal patron) and then on to Scandinavia where he shared the Good News with great success, establishing Catholicism there and into the northern part of Europe. He's famous for pioneering the confessional and private confession.

Four great saints who certainly challenge us to be on the move sharing that same Good News.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

<u>Matrimony</u>: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




