

Dear People of God,

Today we begin the solemn celebration of Holy Week. I invite all of you to fully immerse vourselves in the celebrations during the days ahead; after all, Jesus immersed himself fully so that you might savor the freedom of salvation. Wednesday you could easily make your way to the Cathedral for Tenebrae if you didn't make a reservation to accompany me at the same service in Archbold. Holy Thursday we'll be "at home" for the Lord's Supper and the beginning of his passion. Good Friday we can walk with the Lord as he makes his pilgrim way to the cross for our benefit. Of course, the very acme of our Liturgical Year occurs at the Easter Vigil Saturday evening. Please take time to make time to attend all or at least some of these important annual celebrations commemorating God's love for his people.

Today is Palm Sunday which is an intriguing name for the day considering that the Universal Church more often uses olive branches for the processionals than it does palms. The olive is an interesting tree which makes it appropriate for the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem as the conquering king, an event symbolized by his deliberately riding on a donkey: that was the way any conquering king came into the conquered town so everybody knew there was nothing they could do against him. The people, however, threw branches over the road as Jesus entered the city, more than likely to cut the dust rising from the unpaved roadway.

Any of the scholarly class watching all of this would have quickly understood what was going on: Jesus claims to be king and sacrifice. Remember, Jerusalem is in a dry region where branches were rare and would have been gathered up by the pilgrims to stoke their Passover fire to roast the lamb.

For many of us, Palm Sunday is a mere recollection of things past; however, for the faithful who understand the richness of Jesus' sacrificial gift of self to the Father, Palm Sunday brings us to the real event. We don't just listen to the story of his entry into Jerusalem: we are there to see it, hear it, even smell the dust rising from the street and our own loud Hosannas ring out with those of the others who recognize Jesus as conquering king and sacrifice.

Many of us will take a sprig or two of palm home with us and place it a position of honor — in my house growing up, it was tucked behind a corner of the Last Supper scene, very appropriate given that Palm Sunday leads so inexorably to Jesus final meal shared with his disciples on Holy Thursday. As we keep holy this day, let us remind ourselves that it is just the beginning of a week-long pilgrimage to salvation.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

<u>Matrimony</u>: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.






