

#### Dear People of God,

A happy Mother's day to all of our moms and grandmoms.

As we celebrate Mother's Day, we should be reminded of the universal mother of us all, Mary the Mother of God. The notion of the importance and necessity of mothers dates way back into history and has, until recently, largely been a religious celebration of motherhood rather than an opportunity to get a day off from work. Ancient societies had particular rituals which honored and fostered motherhood.

Interestingly enough, here in the USA it was a mother "in the early 20th century at the initiative of Anna Jarvis, who organized the first Mother's Day service of worship and celebration at Andrews Methodist Episcopal Church in Grafton, West Virginia." She urged her pastor to set aside one weekend of the year to honor the mothers of the parish with special songs, hymns and prayers. Thus let us offer our prayers this day for the women who bore us, in thanksgiving for their willingness to raise us and begin our education, for advising us as we moved on toward independence and who still hold us dear and in their own prayers whether here on earth or in heaven above. God's richest blessings, too, on the virtue of motherhood. Being a mother lately has come on hard times with many women preferring to avoid it by any means rather than embrace it as their God-given privilege and blessing. We all had a mom and we all need one still. Without them there would be no "us" or anyone else.

The celebration of Mary the Mother of God is far older than Mother's Day but shares much in common with the civil celebration. Mary's role as mother of Jesus has always been held in high regard by the faithful who see in this gentle woman a role model for their own maternal role. On the other side of this coin is the reverence paid to Mary because of her intimate relationship to God even before she bore Jesus. Chosen from among women, she was unique in her love for God and all God's creation, especially you and me. We trust that in Mary we always have a caring intercessor at the throne of God who can convey our true feelings, needs and hopes, who can urge God to comfort us in our losses and champion us in our battles, to welcome us eventually into her son's kingdom. Because Jesus has adopted all of us into his family, we can truly claim Mary as our Mother. Let us offer prayers of thanks to Jesus for his kindness to all of us and to Mary that she might lovingly remember each of us today and always before her son.

#### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults</u>**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick**: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.





### Health News for May 8, 2022

**Nurture Your Resilience: Finding** Your Strengths. Stress can cause wear and tear on the body and brain. Chronic stress has been linked to an increased risk of many health conditions. These include heart disease, high blood pressure, depression, and anxiety. Many stressful situations can't easily be changed by one person. And some-such as parenting or a challenging job-can be things you want to do, even if they're taxing. But resilience isn't just about eliminating stress. It's also about tapping into your strengths. Researchers call these protective factors. "They can buffer stress or directly promote well-being-and sometimes even do both," Wexler says. Your strengths include those of your neighborhood and community. Different cultures have developed different ways to help people cope. The ceremonies, teachings, and cultural practices that are meaningful to you can help, Wexler says. Other protective factors involve nurturing your body. "Being able to manage your stress is key to what underlies resilience. And a healthy body is going to deal with stress much better," says Bergeman. Other tools are emotional, like expressing your feelings rather than bottling them up, she explains. Looking at problems from different angles can help, too.
