Music, decorations and special content will help parishioners study an important and often forgotten part of Catholic ritual during Advent. Look for more information and opportunities to participate in the upcoming months.

The Liturgy Committee also helps plan and assist with the special liturgies at the Historic Church of Saint Patrick during the year. The Firefighter's Mass in September, the White Mass in October, St. Patrick's Mass in March and the Blue Mass in May are important to the parish and require special attention to detail.




