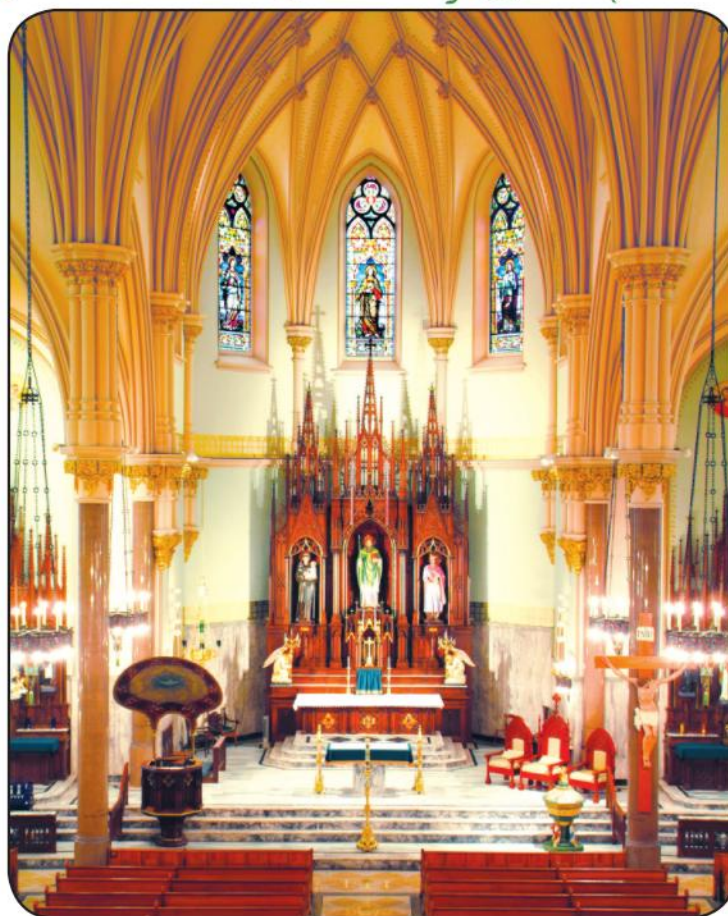

Dear People of God,

A couple of weeks ago I mentioned that time has flown and so it has – we're on the cusp of another school year. It's also time to consider education outside the classroom, although I hope you'll be aware of the needs of our school children and perhaps make available supplies and such for the classroom.

As Christians our Baptismal Promises pointed us to ongoing and continuous growth in knowledge of the Church and her Ministry and Mission. Sadly, many believe that formal spiritual education ends after Confirmation; in my case that would have ended religious formation when I was in the fifth grade. Imagine what my letters would be like had that occurred – although come to think of it, I had originally intended to be a nuclear engineer and make oodles of money so maybe I should have stopped learning about God and Church! At any rate, now is the time when parishes retool for another series of Bible Studies, Formation programs and the RCIA for those interested in joining our wonderful Church.

None of these programs is there just to be there; they all exist and are being made available to help you keep your Baptismal Promises. It's one thing to say we believe in God the Father, but another all together to understand in a deep way what that means and what it implies for our own lives and role in the Church.

It's one thing to listen to the Word proclaimed every Sunday, but something else to dive into the Scriptures and discover why the Church chose a particular medley of readings for a particular Sunday. It's one thing to sing *For all the saints who from their labors rest* and quite another to know who those saints are and what they can do for us today.

As autumn approaches and vacation times are put behind us, the parish invites you to take part in continuing your faith formation. It's good for you and your soul and good for the whole parish to have a larger number of people who are "in the know." Watch the bulletin for announcements of programs, times and places. And please join one or another. If you don't find something to your taste here, check out the bulletins on-line of other parishes and wend you way to a greater knowledge and love of God and Church. As I noted a few weeks ago, opportunities exist; you are invited to seize one.

### **The Celebration of Sacraments**

**Infant Baptism:** The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance:** The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony:** Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

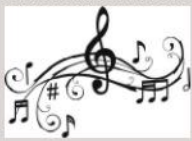

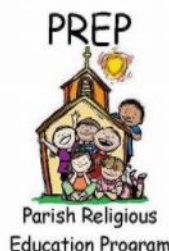

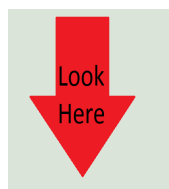
