


Historic St. Patrick



Living Christ, the Diocesan Capital Campaign, has begun in our area. The goal established for our parish is one and a half times the annual Sunday offerings averaged over the past three years (exclusive of Covid). 35% of that goal will be retained for use here in the parish. I've put together a chart that indicates how much each of us can participate in making the goal realizable. It's based on the 1.5 ratio mentioned above. So, if you regularly donate, the chart below will help you figure out what a five-year redemption would mean.

September Pints with the Pastor


September 14th






