“The Angel Tree”

For our community outreach this Christmas season we have adopted a family in need, from a local shelter here in downtown Toledo called **“Leading Families Home”**

Leading Families Home mission is helping families achieve independence and economic stability by providing life-changing resources, including mental wellness, education, employment services and safe, affordable, sustainable housing. We guide families from homelessness to housing in economic stability through trauma-informed case management, behavior health, education, and employment services. Hope is found when you enter our doors.

Leading Families Home is a 501C3 charity based in Toledo, Ohio. We provide resources to support homeless families as they transition to permanent housing.

Starting November 13th, there will be an “Angel Tree” in the back of the church with paper angel ornaments on it. On the tag will be the information for one of the children or their Mother, their age and what they would need or like for Christmas. We are hoping for all of the tags to be chosen and gift purchased.

The gifts will need to be wrapped (if possible, please) with the angel tags taped to the gift.
Place your gift under the tree on or before December 11th.

December 11th the gifts will be taken to Leading Families Home. They will be delivered to the families in time for Christmas.

Serving those who Serve

Dear Father,

Allow me to express my profound gratitude to you and your parish community for participating in the upcoming National Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS). As you know, the collection is approved by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops to be taken every three years, to both increase awareness and support of the mission, *“Serving Those Who Serve.”*

The ministries offered by the AMS benefit those who serve in all six branches of the U.S. Armed Forces, Veterans, and their families. It is the mission of this Archdiocese that they be able to seek sacramental preparation for baptism, confirmation, first Communion, penance, and marriage; to benefit from consultation with a priest, and to receive the sacrament of penance as they defend our rights of freedom and speech, and face constant transition and uncertainty.

In addition, the AMS Co-Sponsored Seminarian Program is the only vocations program in the United States that provides priests to serve as military chaplains - and also to serve in parishes and dioceses across the country that struggle with their own critical shortage of ministers. After a seminarian receives approval from his bishop or religious superior to participate, education and other formation costs are shared between the AMS and the seminarian's home diocese or religious order. Once the priest is ordained, he first serves for three years in his home diocese or community before being released for full-time military service for at least five years. When the priest separates from the military, he then returns to his diocese or community.

Please help me continue to provide for those entrusted to my pastoral care – *including those who originate from your own parish or diocese* - by including one or more bulletin announcements in your weekly publication, making collection envelopes readily available, and perhaps consider having an active-duty or retired military member of your parish offer a witness to having been able to receive the sacraments or counsel from an AMS endorsed priest while they served on active-duty.

Please pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Know that your intentions will be remembered at the altar.






Broadening Services to the Spiritually and Physically Impoverished

While the offices provide immediate services and ministries to Lucas, Richland, Huron, and Erie counties, the lack of coverage in all 19 of the diocesan counties creates an opportunity for expanded services and new locations. Over the last decade, the number of individuals in need of the services Catholic Charities provides (food, clothing, shelter, rent and utility assistance, furniture, jail and prison ministry, and case management) has more than doubled from 20,000 to 45,000 annually. Supporting existing ministries and broadening our outreach throughout the diocese by establishing a presence in as many communities as possible, urban and rural, will be a step in the right direction toward helping and serving more people.

Support for Helping Hands

Located just east of downtown Toledo, Helping Hands of St. Louis serves low-income and homeless families and individuals. This ministry serves as a direct lifeline for families and children who are in need of food, clothing, and heartfelt care. To ensure that the thousands who receive these services can continue doing so in a dignified way, capital improvements must be made to the existing campus including:

- Demolition of the existing food center and building a new one at a suitable site
- Renovations to the existing clothing center




Blessed Duns Scotus
