Dear People of God,

I'm again interrupting the series I began on hell and sin this week to address a serious issue facing the parish – the upcoming 160th Anniversary of the Historic Church of St. Patrick. We missed the more often celebrated sesquicentennial because Fr. Hartigan was leaving and I was arriving. However, we have all the more reason to celebrate given those extra ten years of growth in Mission and Ministry. I'll have more to say about that as the year progresses but I want to point out a couple of dates to put on your calendar now so you can't say you didn't know when they arrive.

The first is Sunday, January 29th. One hundred and sixty years ago the first mass was celebrated in the completed first church on the Feast of St. Bridget of Kildare; the celebrant was the Most Reverend John Henry Luers, first bishop of Fort Wayne, Indiana. Bishop Luers dedicated the parish that day to the patronage of St. Patrick. There's an interesting back-story as to why Bishop Luers was called upon to head up that significant ceremony which you will hear at mass that day. The current bishop of Fort Wayne, the Most Reverend Kevin Rhodes, has graciously agreed to travel to Toledo and serve as principal celebrant and homilist at the 10:00 am Mass.

In 1863 the church was standing room only for the dedication ceremonies, in excess of 800 men and women (the pews had a capacity of 500), Catholic and Protestant, Irish, German and English, young and old, the high and the mighty and the ordinary residents of shanty town below the looming tower of the new church.

It was cold outside and inside the unheated church and there were no electric lights and no sound system but those in attendance were fervent in their appreciation for the parish and her people.

I invite you all to become part of another standing room gathering on January 29th to show Bishop Rhodes your love of St. Patrick and the parish he watches over here in Toledo. Invite your family and friends, Catholic and non -Catholic alike, to participate in this joyous renewal of that day one hundred and sixty years ago.

There are other dates for the calendar, but the one you'll want to mark down now is the week beginning July 30 and ending August 7. In addition to a wealth of fun activities including for you golf enthusiasts an outing at Belmont County Club, our special guest will be Fr. James McDonagh, pastor of Immaculate Conception parish in Ballymoat, County Sligo, Ireland – the home place of our founder Fr. Edward Anthony Hannin. Our own Immaculate Conception was named for this Irish parish, you know. Fr. Jim, will be here the entire week so plan now on extending the hospitality of our parish family.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

<u>Matrimony</u>: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.





Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency
