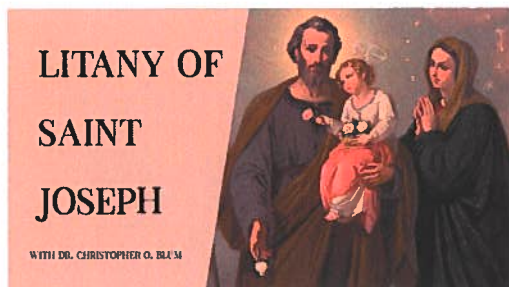

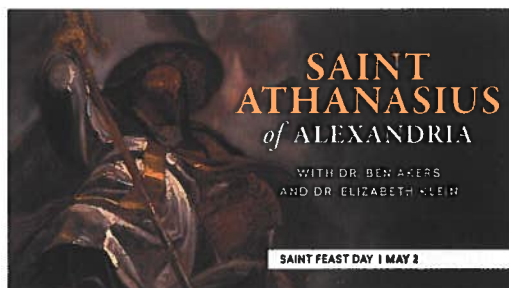
## St. Joseph: Old and New (Part 1 of 4)

Now is the time to do your research and order a County kilt.  
Celebrate your Irish heritage and St. Patrick's history!



Information on where to find and order/purchase your County kilt are on the back. These are just a few suggestions from Msgr. Chris.

## Kilt Suppliers

**Got Kilt** (gotkilt.com) – located in Frankenmuth they have a wide variety of clans and counties in stock. They can custom order some county kilts and can have the pleats of utility kilts (generally black denim when hanging closed) in any desired tartan clan or county custom made. Prices for in stock are around \$69.00 but you can often find a nice acrylic for \$58.00 if you shop in the store.

**Atlanta Kilts** (atlantakilts.com) – have a variety of rental and made to order kilts in most counties and clans. Made to order begin around \$89.00. Some used rentals are sell for around \$49.00. Notre Dame fans might want to get one like the pipers wear before football games in South bend. It's a high end tartan, though.

**Men Kilts** (menkilts.com) – a more limited variety although proud Americans might want to check out the flag themed utility kilt at \$79.00.

**Super Kilts** (superkilts.com) can special order any county or clan from their factory in Scotland around \$250.00 because they're genuine wool.

**DNKE** (damnnearkitlem.com) has a variety of traditional kilts starting at \$69.00. The *Stowaway*, which is a utility kilt in brown denim is \$99.00. It's a good choice for those who don't want a Sporrans or who prefer pockets. It has six.

**Amazon** (amazon.com) Sell a number of different makers, beginning at \$24.00.

### **The "other" includes:**

Knee length stockings, usually white wool.

Sporran – the pocket on a chain that hangs in front

Flashes – tartan matching the kilt worn with the stockings
