For our community outreach this Christmas season we have adopted a family in need, from a local shelter here in downtown Toledo called “**Leading Families Home**”

Leading Families Home mission is helping families achieve independence and economic stability by providing life-changing resources, including mental wellness, education, employment services and safe, affordable, sustainable housing. We guide families from homelessness to housing in economic stability through trauma-informed case management, behavior health, education, and employment services. Hope is found when you enter our doors.

Leading Families Home is a 501C3 charity based in Toledo, Ohio. We provide resources to support homeless families as they transition to permanent housing.

Starting November 22nd, there will be an “Angel Tree” in the back of the church with paper angel ornaments on it. On the tag will be the information for one of the children or their Mother, their age and what they would need or like for Christmas. We are hoping for all of the tags to be chosen and gift purchased.


The gifts will need to be wrapped (if possible, please) with the angel tags taped to the gift. Place your gift under the tree on or before December 10th.

December 11th the gifts will be taken to Leading Families Home. They will be delivered to the families in time for Christmas.

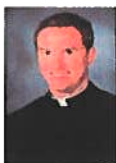

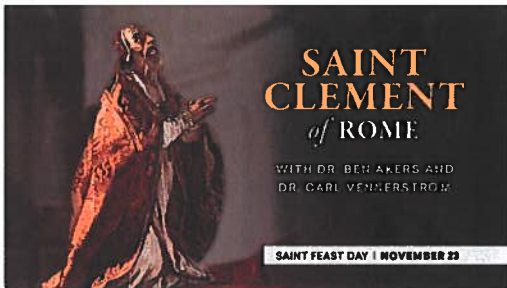

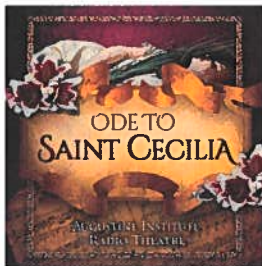
