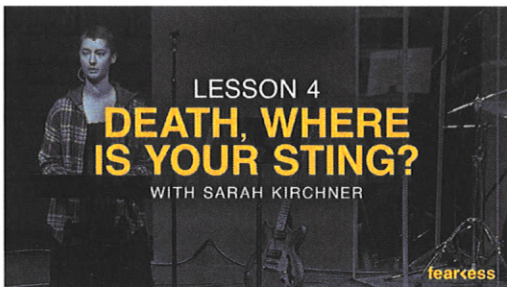
Liturgical Living | Catholic All Year at Home w/ Kendra Tierney
