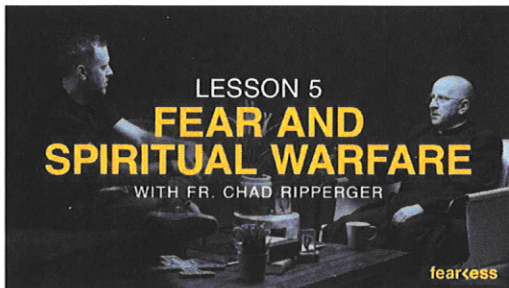

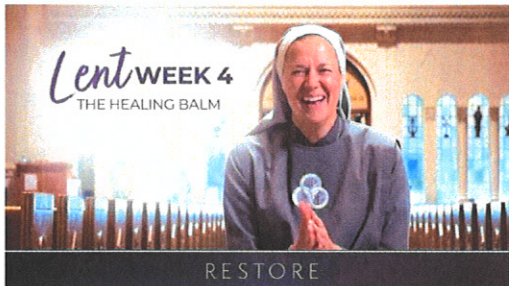

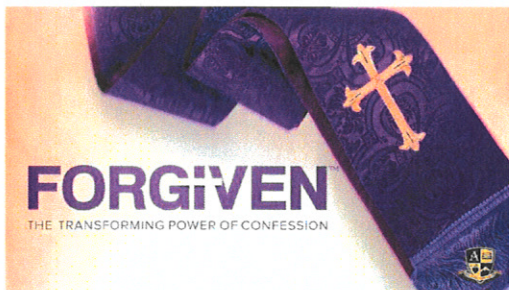
Fear and Spiritual Warfare w/ Fr. Chad Ripperger | Fearless | Episode 5
