

Dear friends, visitors, peace officers and guests,

Welcome one and all to our celebration here in Toledo of the national event known as the Blue Mass. The Blue Mass dates to September 29, 1934, when Reverend Thomas Dade started the service as part of his duties with the Catholic Police and Fireman's Society. The first mass, which was held at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Washington, D.C., has grown to a nationwide celebration to honor those who daily risk their lives "to serve and to protect." We join millions all across the land who will be gathering at local churches, cathedrals, stadiums and tiny chapels to observe the day and offer thanks. While we tender our warmest welcome and prayerful support to the living, we also recall the memory of those who have served, both those who were taken from us by acts of violence while on duty and those who have gone ahead of us to the Kingdom of God's promise after their years of dedicated service.

While the Blue Mass is a uniquely Catholic service structured around our sacramental life and celebration, it embraces both men and women of all faiths along with those of no faith who don the uniform, walk the streets, patrol the highways and guard our cities, towns and countryside so that the rest of us can sleep in peace knowing we are safe.

Our gathering today goes far beyond city police and county sheriffs; it includes railroad police, MPS and others in the military police as well as highway patrol members and marshals; our prayers are offered for all who in any way stand on the line for the good of others.

As part of our support for police, we here at the Historic Church of St. Patrick maintain a close watch on events around the country; we raise up our prayers for places where tensions are strong and lift up in prayer those who sacrifice all for their comrades and communities, for their families and friends.

To all who have joined us, know that you remain always in our prayers; our concern for you is unending. May you be blessed with the safety of St. Michael, the patron of police officers, and may God bring you safely home.

#### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
