

Revelations from Our Divine Lord concerning reparation to His Holy Face as told to Sister Mary of St. Peter:

"By offering My Face to my Eternal Father nothing will be refused, and the conversion of many sinners will be obtained."

"Offer my Face to My Father — it is the only means whereby to appease Him — appease Divine Justice. If you only knew how powerful is its virtue - and the reason is that I have taken upon my own head all the sins of humanity in order that my members may be spared."

"As in a kingdom you can procure all you wish for with a coin marked with the King's effigy, so in the Kingdom of Heaven you will obtain all you desire with the precious coin of My Holy Face."

"According to the care you take in making reparations to My Face, disfigured by blasphemers, I will take care of yours, which has been disfigured by sin. I will reprint on it My Image, and render it as beautiful as it was on leaving the Baptismal Font."


The Triumph of the Immaculate Heart
