

Dear People of God,

We are continuing to dive into Irish history because so much of what we know as "Church" derives from the Irish experience. You may recall that I mentioned St. Parick establishing many cathedrals. We ordinarily think of a cathedral as big, looming, dark building which can accommodate several thousand people (Queen of the Most Holy Rosary could easily seat three thousand if chairs were put in the side aisles - there are European cathedrals which can 'seat' ten thousand because everybody stands through the entire service); however, we should not think of Patrick's cathedrals on that scale. Keep in mind that he was converting pagans so there weren't a lot of Catholics around in his time. However, he felt the need for the bishop to be present to the people, much like Pope Francis recommends today that the Shepherd smell like the Sheep. Cathedrals of his era were small, comfortable places where the bishop could mingle with his flock and allow them to know him as he knew them. Patrick understood the imagery of the Body of Christ and wanted that Body to know everyone who was part of it in the local Church. Here's a photo of Ardmore Cathedral on the site of an oratory built by St. Declan. The cathedral was built around 1200 so it's easy to see by comparing to the tombstones around it that there still weren't a lot of people in a diocese!

A much older oratory (a church not generally used as a parish church so without a baptistry) is that of St. Finbar at Gougane Barra built much earlier. The trees growing in it give a good notion of its dimensions but in case you wonder, it's about forty feet long and twelve wide. It dates to the sixth century.

These differences do not diminish the feats of having built cathedrals but make them easier for us to understand those impressive accomplishments.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Health News for June 9, 2024

Blood flow with Postural Orthostatic Tachycardia Syndrome. Normally when a person stands, gravity pulls blood down toward the legs and feet. This briefly reduces blood flow to the upper body, including the heart and brain. So the brain immediately sends signals that tighten the body's lower vessels and make the heart pump faster. This pushes blood upward, so t can travel throughout the body. For people with POTS these signals break down. The lower blood vessels don't tighten enough upon standing, and the heart beats much faster than it should. The brain and other organs may not get enough blood, which can lead to fainting and other symptoms.
