DAY 1 Monday, July 28: Depart for Italy

Depart Detroit Metropolitan Wayne County Airport on our overseas journey to Rome. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board.

DAY 2 Tuesday, July 29: Welcome to Rome! | Assisi

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet our Peter's Way Tour Manager as we exit from Customs and Baggage Claim. Board our private touring bus and we'll be on our way to Assisi (2.5-hour drive). Independent lunch en route to Assisi. Upon arrival we'll visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great basilica built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the Saint died. We will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Santa Maria degli Angeli. After Mass, check-in at our hotel in Assisi.

DAY 3 Wednesday, July 30: Sites of St. Francis and

<u>St. Clare</u>

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis. After Mass, our local guide will take us to explore the basilica complex, which is composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. Continue to the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement. View her remains and see the miraculous crucifix. Independent lunch in Assisi. This afternoon, we'll visit the Sanctuary of the Renunciation which is part of the Church of St. Mary Major where the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis is located on the spot where a young St. Francis of Assisi is said to have cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. Pray near the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, the young Catholic from Italy who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

Option: Possible hike to visit Eremo delle Carceri, a hermitage complex on the slopes of Mt. Subasio. The core of the hermitage is the actual rock cave where Francis would often withdraw for prayer and contemplation. See St. Francis's cave and the original oratory, as well as the oak tree near a stone bridge where St. Francis preached his sermon to the birds. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (B,D)

DAY 4 Thursday, July 31: Assisi to Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll **celebrate Mass at the shrine of Blessed Carlo Acutis.** After Mass time will be given for prayer and reflection. Late morning, we'll leave Assisi for the "Eternal City." Independent lunch en-route to Rome.

Upon arrival in Rome, we'll have an orientation tour of the ancient Roman Forum. See the Arch of Titus and the Arch of Constantine and proceed to the outside of the Colosseum for a fascinating explanation of its history. Continue to the grandiose white marble monument of King Victor Emmanuel II, often called the "Wedding Cake." See Trajan's Column and the Market (the ancient Roman equivalent of a department store). After our visit, we'll check-in at our hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 5 Friday, August 1: Jubilee For Young People | Holy Doors of Rome*

Breakfast at our hotel. Today we'll participate in the programming the Jubilee For Young People which will include passing through of the Holy Doors of the Papal Basilicas. The main distinction of the Papal Basilicas is that they each have a special "holy door" which a opened only during Jubilee years. Throughout the days of the Jubiliour group will assigned a scheduled time to visit and pass through the Holy Doors of one the following Papal Basilicas:

• St. Peter's Basilica welcomes all who come to Rome! Obtain to Jubilee indulgence and encounter Christ, the "door" who unites us we the Father. The door is always open to those who convert their lives.

- Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major basilicas built Pope Sixtus III (432-440 A.D.). View the impressive interior with remarkable mosaics depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. View the icon Sal Populi Romani, Protectress of the Roman People, believed to I painted by St. Luke. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome.
- Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to I consecrated. It was founded by the Emperor Constantine in the 4 century and was home to the Popes for many years prior to the prese Vatican residence. From there we will go to Sanctuary of the Passic of Christ which in under the care of the Passionists. According Christian tradition, St. Helena, the mother of Constantine, had the Hc Stairs (Scala Sancta) transported from Pontius Pilate's Palace Jerusalem to Rome. For those who are able, you may climb the sta on your knees, meditating on the Passion of Christ.

• Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4 century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. Surrounding the nave a medallions of each pope, from St. Peter to Pope Francis.

Independent lunch.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome.

DAY 6 Saturday, August 2: Pilgrimage Walk 1 Vigil Site | Prayer Vigil with Pope Francis

Breakfast at our hotel. Our hotel rooms will be secured for the evenin so pack appropriately for our overnight campout. We will join the mittude of pilgrims on a walking pilgrimage to the vigil site.

This evening, the Holy Father will lead us in Adoration, Prayer ar Benediction.

DAY 7 Sunday, August 3: Closing Papal Mass Historic Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. Jubilee of Young People Closing Mass with tl Holy Father (subject to confirmation). Independent lunch.

After lunch, we'll go on a walking tour and experience the best ancient Rome. Begin at the Pantheon. Built more than 1,800 years ag the magnificent Pantheon still stands as a reminder of the great Rome Empire. The name Pantheon refers to the building's original function as a temple for the gods. When approaching the front of the Pantheouse can still see the original Latin dedication by Marcus Agripp Continue to the Church of San Luigi dei Francesi to see the stunning interior, which is home to a trio of Caravaggio masterpieces. Then we walk to the Trevi Fountain and Piazza di Spagna, one of the most famous squares in Rome. See the Fontanna della Barcaccia (Fountate of the Old Boat) in the middle of the piazza and enjoy the view fro the famous Spanish Steps.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 8 Monday, August 4: Return from Rome After breakfast, transfer to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for o return flight home. (B)

This pilgrimage entails a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc.
Participants must be medically and physically fit for this type of travel.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2025, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip estimated economy class airfare from Detroit. Rates will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary.
