The Nursing Honor Guard Program.

This is a very inspirational/emotional ceremony for deceased nurses sponsored by the UAW. It only lasts about five minutes with a member of the Guard telling a little about the career of the deceased, the Florence Nightingale Pledge is recited, the deceased's name is repeated x3 with the ringing of a bell. At the conclusion the candle in the Nightingale lamp is extinguished, the nurse is told they are relieved of their nursing duty. Nurses are encouraged to talk to their family about the service. 




