

Dear Parishioners and Friends of the Preservation Society of the Historic Church of St. Patrick,

Over the past several years, despite numerous necessary repairs and projects, the Parish Finance Committee has been able to steward the resources of St. Patrick's with an eye toward establishing a permanent foundation or endowment with which to assure that future generations will be able to celebrate the Presence of Jesus Christ in these sacred precincts just as we do today and past generations have done since 1863.

An endowment is a stable fund which accepts large and small donations to create a significant source of regular earnings with which to plan and undertake both scheduled and unexpected repairs and improvements on the campus. Creating an endowment requires meeting the expectations of both secular and church rules and regulations to ensure proper due diligence and fiduciary accountability. I am pleased to report that all has been done to meet those expectations: The Historic Church of St. Patrick now has the Margaret Tank Preservation Endowment, Historic Church of St. Patrick. To establish the fund, the Finance Committee approved depositing \$1,000,000 which will become the "corpus," i.e. the untouchable fund which will generate a regular income. I am equally pleased to report that since its establishment, this endowment has already received 2 major donations of \$10,000 and \$9,800.


Future significant moments of growth will be reported in the bulletin so that we can all rest assured of a bright future for the parish and its campus. In the future when fundraising for the Preservation Society, a portion of what we receive will be added to the endowment which means constant growth. We will also recruit significant substantial donations to further augment the essential body of the endowment with a goal of building a fund whose annual return can underwrite all major projects, many of which have not occurred because we just don't have the necessary funds now.

You'll be hearing more about the endowment and ways and means of growing it in the future but for now, let us give thanks to God that we are in a position to undertake this great new work on behalf of the parish and her people.




