Dear people of God,

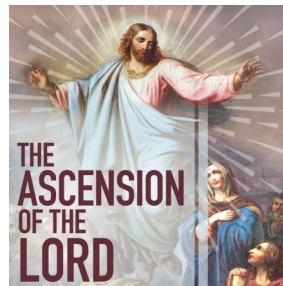
Ah, summer has begun! Yes, I know that the season only begins on the solstice but for most of us, once Memorial Day shows up on the calendar, it's summer! Although it isn't as common as it once was, summer is a time for family vacations, getting away to the cottage, wonderful day trips on the weekends and all but forgetting the parish and Mass.

As a matter of fact, our Sunday obligation doesn't go away for three months through the summer. The expectation is that we continue to be part of a praying community rejoicing in the gift of the true presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. When traveling outside our usual haunts, it's easy to find a nearby parish where we can evangelize by our presence. Simply Google "find a parish" and input where you'll be in the US, Canada or almost anywhere in the world. An alternative is an APP (may even be in the APP section of your phone) titled "MassTimes-Find a Catholic Mass-Home" Touching it will give you "mass times". Those who regularly spend time at the family cottage likely already know where the local parish is; in case that cottage is a new acquisition, you can google/APP a parish just as easily as travelers can.

With long, warm evenings, summer is also a great time to put away the cell phone or tablet, turn off the computer or television and spend some quality time in the open marveling at the magnificence of the song of the birds, watching the clouds majestically fly overhead or just sitting sharing the warm embrace of the sun and giving thanks to God whose gift all of that is.

Listening is a form of prayer so in the midst of the chirping of the sparrows, the melodies of the lark or the barking of the neighbor's dog, we might be able to hear the gentle whisper of God telling us how wonderfully made we are.

Perhaps one or two of those weekend trips might include a deliberate choice to visit a particular church or shrine; depending on your timing, you might even make mass attendance particularly memorable. You can make it to the national Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima in New York in about five hours, or take in Niagara Falls and the Shrine of Our Lady of Victory in Lackawanna all in a two-day trip (I've done it in one but most people don't like leaving at 5:00). Or how about a quick trip to the Cleveland area to stop in at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe where a weekend would permit a visit to the Christmas Story house and the Superman comic house. A drive up into Michigan could take in Indian River or Our Lady of the Woods. During this Year of Hope, the USCCB has a list of the pilgrimage sites in every diocese with nearby Detroit, Lansing, Fort Wayne-South bend, Cincinnati, Cleveland and Columbus in addition to our own. There are plenty of spiritual places to visit this summer and enjoy all kinds of other places along the way.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

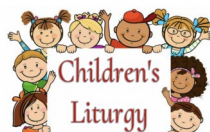

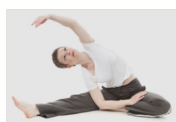

Health News for June 1, 2025

Common Seasonal Allergy Triggers. If you sneeze and cough during certain times of the year, you may have seasonal allergies. However, occasional allergies aren't something you just have to live with. In many areas of the United States, spring allergies begin in February and last until the early summer. Tree pollination begins earliest in the year followed by grass pollination later in the spring and summer and ragweed in the late summer and fall. In tropical climates, however, grass may pollinate throughout a good portion of the year. Mild winter temperatures can cause plants to pollinate early. A rainy spring can also promote rapid plant growth and lead to an increase in mold, causing symptoms to last well into the fall.

The Diocese of Toledo is in compliance with the articles of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People (Charter) of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).

Every year, the Diocese dutifully submits the necessary documentation required by the USCCB for a diocese to be in compliance. Every three years an on-site audit is conducted, when not only all necessary documentation is dutifully submitted, but in addition, Pastoral Center, parish and diocesan school employees are interviewed concerning practices and protocols related to creating and maintaining a safe environment for our children and youth. The last 3-year audit was conducted in September 2024 and all audited Articles within the Charter were found to be compliant. The next on-site audit will be conducted in 2027.

The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. If you have any knowledge of abuse that has been committed by a cleric, or any personnel of the Catholic Church, you are urged to report the abuse to your local police department, Children Services, and the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at (419) 214-4880 or by mail at 1933 Spielbusch Avenue, Toledo, Ohio 43604.
