

Dear People of God,

I trust everyone is aware that tomorrow morning I will be leading a pilgrimage to Italy for the Year of Hope Jubilee of Youth. Our trip will begin at Assisi where the students from Queen of Apostles, whose dream this pilgrimage was, will venerate the remains of Blessed Calor Acutis, one of the two major patrons of the Eucharistic Renewal which concludes this year. We will then head down to Rome for the Celebration of Youth at a variety of events concluding with a Mass.

I ask that you say a few prayers for the young people going to Italy. I've been there before but for the students, this will be a rare opportunity to take advantage of the generosity of many of you who donated to their various fundraisers. The names of all the donors, if not the amount of the gift, have been given to all the participants; they will be praying for you as they experience the heart of our Universal Church. Keep an eye on the Facebook page for some brief video reports by the students over the next week or so.

Pope Leo will canonize Carlo and Pier Giorgio on September 7th. The canonizations will be of two young people to be heralded as saints, those we believe to be truly present to the fullness of the Kingdom. Pope Francis who did much to bring about a greater sense of the synodality of the Church (the universal call to be involved at every level), believes that we are losing a lot of real talent and grace by excluding the young from positions of leadership. That was not always the case. In my book examining the apostles in the four gospels, I make note that Jesus chose a lot of very young men, perhaps teenagers, to undertake the founding of his Church. St. Paul consecrated both Timothy and Titus as bishops while they were very young; thus, we know that synodality at one time embraced youthful, energetic people in the forefront of the Church's Mission and Ministry. Pope Francis wanted to see some of that return to the ordinary operation of our parishes, dioceses and even the Universal Church.

Several years ago, there was a major effort to initialize an intergenerational catechesis as a possible first step toward just such a restoration. A major grant from the Lilly Foundation made the program available to any parish that wanted to give it a try and a couple here in Toledo signed on. Unfortunately, those parishes experienced the same thing Timothy and Titus did – pressure to leave the young behind because "what do they know?" So easily writing off the gifts and talents of the Spirit poured out in our young may well lead to the young going elsewhere to make use of those gifts. What a tragedy that would be and unfortunately is. Consider including in your prayers support for the late Pope Francis's goal to incorporate the talents of our young people in the Church's Mission and Ministry.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults</u>: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
