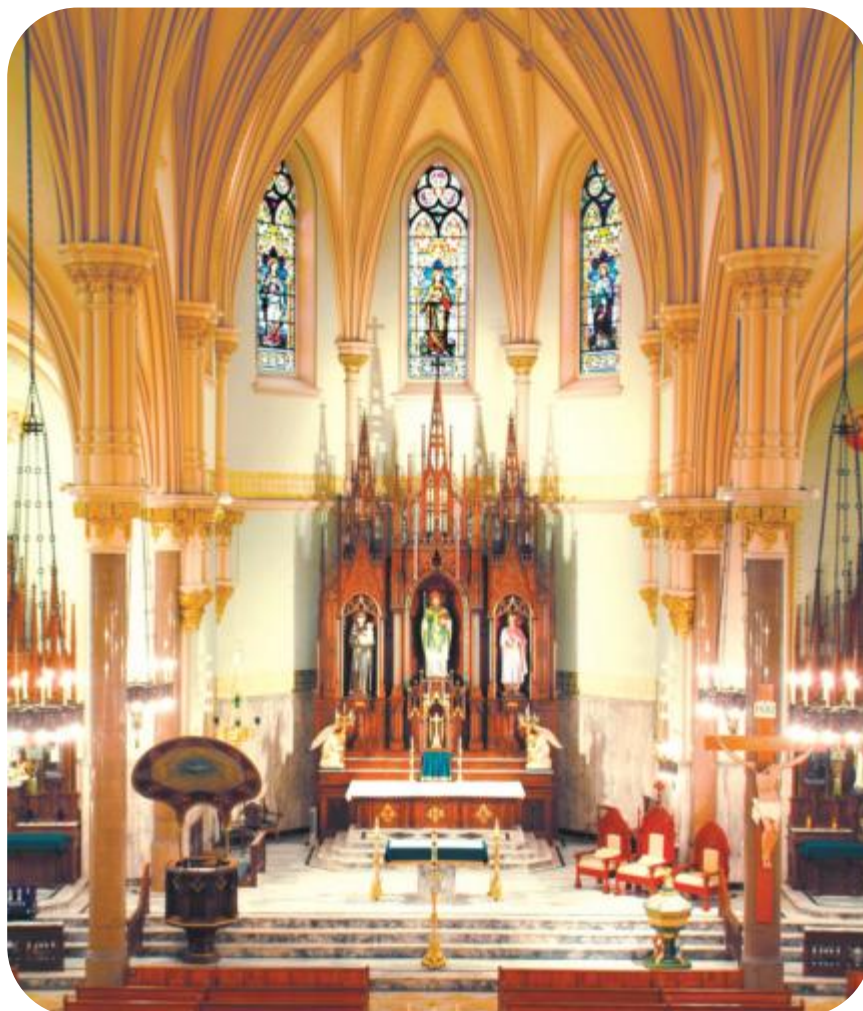

Dear People of God,

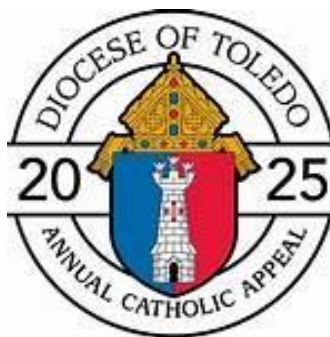
I know no one likes to talk money, but that touchy subject requires consideration, in particular about the Annual Catholic Appeal. Every registered Catholic family should have received at least two notifications from the Diocese about this important fund-raising effort on behalf of the mission and ministry of the diocese. Funds contributed to the ACA are used exclusively for the work of the Church and do not underwrite the expenses of "operating the diocese."

The brochures sent to each of us outlined the many ministerial programs which, together with 121 other parishes, we can provide for all. Not least among these is the Vocations Department which funds the educational formation of future priests. Over the forty years since I was ordained, the cost of educating, housing and forming young men for serving us in the parishes has, like everything else, suffered the bitter pangs of inflation. It now costs more than twice what it did when I was in the seminary but the giving level to the ACA has not risen at the same rate. I urge you to consider both the gift and the inflation to assure that there will be a priest to serve when I come to the end of my service.

Catholic Charities has also seen great increases in the cost of operating its various programs, including La Posada, housing which you can easily visit next door to Immaculate Conception. In fact, La Posada began as a parish ministry but rising costs and stagnant Sunday collections required surrendering the program to the diocese which, along with several similar programs in other communities, relies on the combined generosity of all 122 parishes to keep the place open. Let's not let rising costs and a stagnant ACA make those services disappear.

I invite all who set aside the ACA materials to take them up and in prayer, consider how you can best assist the men and women of one-hundred and twenty-two parishes which come together to provide that which none can do on its own. Together we all form the Body of Christ in our diocese: all of us should take up the challenge to keep that Body healthy and fully operational. Please do what you can.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

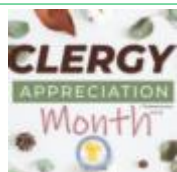
Winter is Just Around the Corner!
